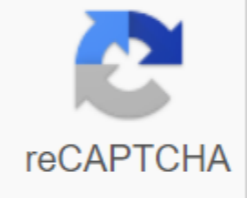

Joseph Anton O'Keefe and Bierstadt: Various presentations of New England Landscapes Pink Moon over Water is a Maine landscape painting that was created circa 1923 by Georgia O'Keefe, a pioneering American modernist artist (O'Keefe). Echo Lake, Franconia Mountains, NH, is a landscape of a lake and a multitude of mountains, as stated in the title, written circa 1861 by Albert Bierstadt, a German American immigrant artist known for his love of the mountains and romanticized depiction of Western American landscapes (Henderson). While both works are prominent in New England landscapes, there are a few key differences that are the result of huge differences in artistic style. O'Keefe, staying true to her modernist roots, depicts her landscape in a simplified or abstract form, omitting the basic details of her scene, as well as through a non-representative choice of color. Contrasting this, Bierstadt gives scenes of intense detail while as idealization of the scene and representation of nature in its most romantic form, thus offering a picturesque view of the landscape with obvious omissions of human presence or natural flaws, which serves to improve its scene. It is immediately clear that both landscapes, in their simplest form, depict a very similar object: the mountains of New England and the water. Bierstadt presents a majestic take on its landscape that uses sunlight to accentuate the fog hovering over the lake in the foreground. This fog is stressed ...
