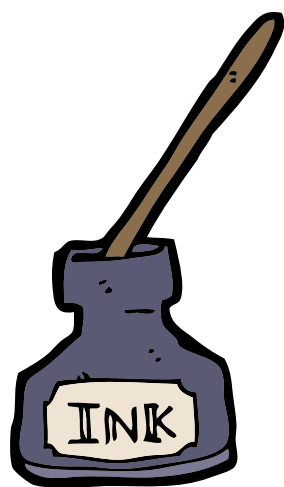

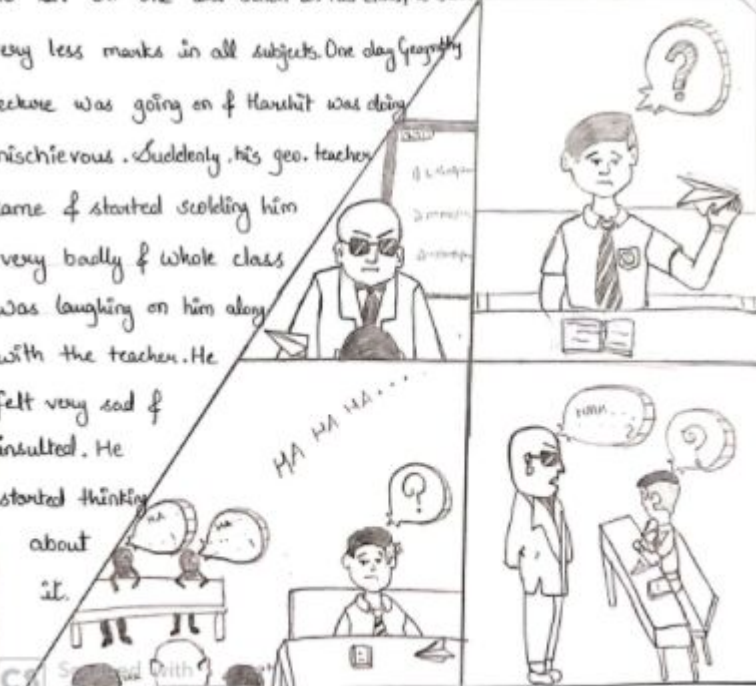

1. Sushma Swaraj's Pre-Marital Name was Sushma Hardev Sharma born in Ambala, Cantt, Haryana. Her parents hailed from Lahore, Pakistan.
2. Her interest : Classical music, poetry, fine arts and drama too.
3. Starting her political career in early 1970's, joined Akhil Bhartiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP).
4. She became the ever youngest Cabinet Minister in 1977 at the age of 25 in the Janta Party Govt.
5. The first female spokesperson of a National Political Party in India.
6. First Female Chief Minister of Delhi for a short period in 1998 (13 October -3 December).

7. During her tenure as Union Health Minister (January 2003 to May 2004) she opened up All India Institute of Medical Sciences.
8. The Second woman to be India's Minister of External Affairs after Indira Gandhi.
9. In 2017 , Wall Street Journal named her the 'Best-loved' politician in India.
10. She was helpful 24x7 to all the Indians around the world.
11. Last but not the least- Tweet and Viola! Solution Being one of the most tech-savvy ministers. Today we all Indians irrespective of cast, creed and religion mourn her demise and pray to God to let her soul **Rest In Peace**.
