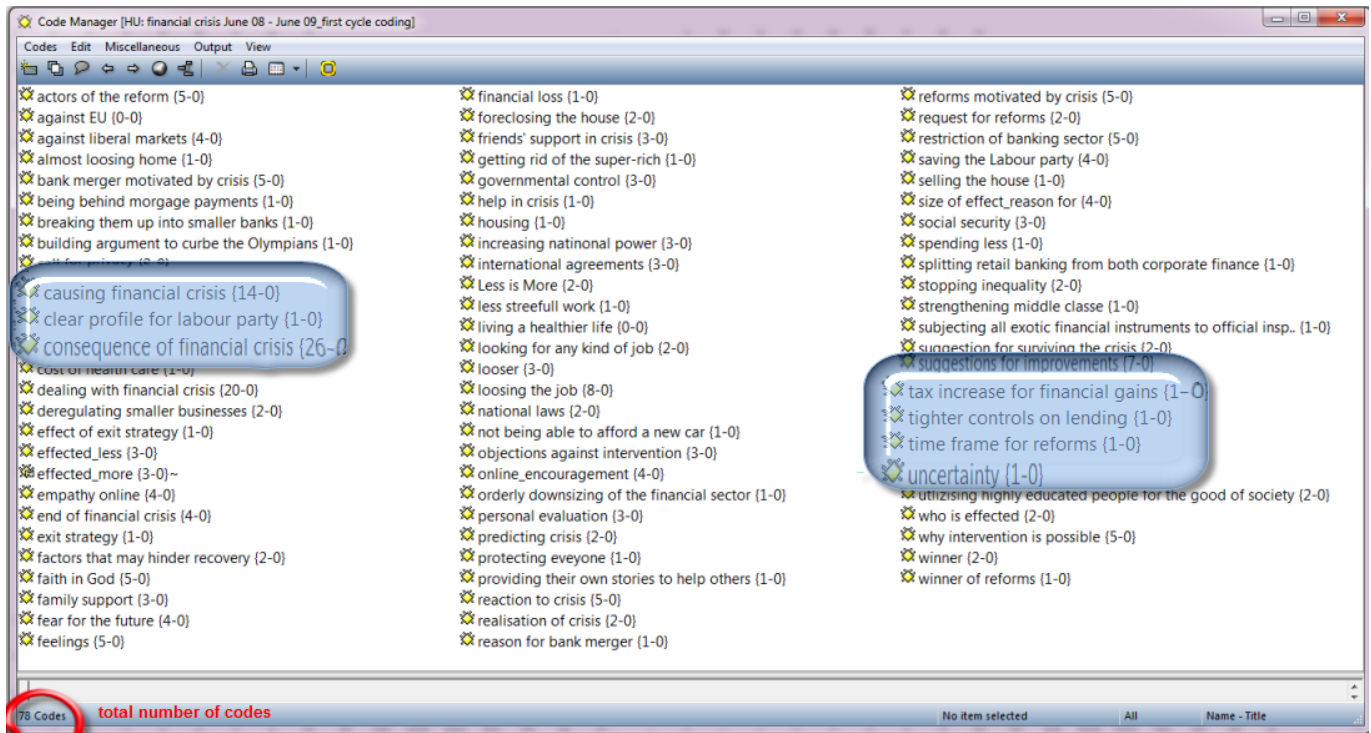

LicenseKey is a String element: --license_key-- In the other xml file, you need to change it to: "--license_key--" Q: Write a function to find and display a form to user I am writing a function that can take a string as an input and should display a form to the user. The form consists of an input box, a label box, and a button. The user enters an integer as an input into the input box. The function should display a form that consists of an input box, a label box, and a button that is to be pressed to get the integer entered by the user. I am not allowed to use the GUI libraries and I have to write the function with a bare-bone simple setup. For example, we can assume that the function should take a string with a format "5+5-3*9/2+2*1". When we call the function, we should see something like this: Input: Enter the product of 5 and 5: 10 20 Enter the product of 3 and 9: 27 Enter the product of 2 and 1: 4 But when I run the program, it never displays the form. My function is like this: void product(string str) { string name = "Product"; 520fdb1ae7
