Human Rights Watch is currently investigating the extrajudicial execution of a video blogger in Balochistan. On Wednesday, August 15, 2009, the Balochistan police shot and killed at least one person and injured more than 40 others when police opened fire on a crowd gathered outside a mosque in Quetta, Pakistan's largest city in the western province of Balochistan. Human Rights Watch called on Pakistani security forces to cease the violence against demonstrators and to take responsibility for the killings. Since 2007, when a video blogger, Bakhoor Sohail, recorded video clips of the separatist insurgency in Balochistan, he has been threatened and attacked by the security forces. On August 15, 2009, the police detained Sohail in the Loralai neighborhood of Quetta and began to beat him. They threw him into a car, where they continued beating him. At a mosque nearby, where the beating continued, police opened fire with live ammunition and rubber bullets. Two passersby were killed and at least 40 others were injured. "The Baloch separatists should stop threatening, attacking, and threatening journalists," said Mina Ahadi, Amnesty International's South Asia researcher. "They are effectively encouraging the security forces to commit crimes against journalists that is clearly contrary to the protections afforded under the Pakistani constitution." Pakistan's constitution gives broad rights to freedom of expression. But the government has used censorship and harassment to limit these rights, especially those of journalists and bloggers. Human Rights Watch documented in a 2009 report that a number of bloggers, including Sohail, have been killed because of their work, their opinions, or criticism of the government. "In light of Sohail's death, we urge the Pakistani authorities to take all necessary steps to hold the perpetrators accountable and ensure that freedom of expression is protected."
