

The Product Game Directions

1. Player A puts a paper clip on a number in the factor list. Player A does not mark a square on the product grid because only one factor has been marked; it takes two factors to make a product.
2. Player B puts the other paper clip on any number in the factor list (including the same number marked by Player A) and then shades the product of the two factors on the product grid.
3. Player A moves either one of the paper clips to another number and then shades the new product.
4. Each player, in turn, moves a paper clip and marks a product. If a product is already marked, the next player goes. The winner is the first player to mark four squares in a row - up and down, across, or diagonally.
