Our AGM (1/2)

For the first 5 years, the Household of Faith is growing to a point that we had a core membership to qualify to register as a religious group with the authorities. Then came the pandemic, when we were no longer able to continue to rent the Metropolitan YMCA without being registered. During the this time, we moved to brother Alfred's house, brother Beng's office, and my former Pasir Panjang office.

When the Pasir Panjang church was due to be demolished for rebuilding, the Household of Faith registered as a company limited by guarantee so that we could legally rent our present meeting place for worship.

After registration, we held the first AGM last year. Since we are already registered, the AGM will get members involved in running the church, transparently and with accountability.

Also, in order to adhere to government regulations, especially the audit of accounts, we employed an accounting firm to prepare and submit the annual returns and audited accounts to ACRA (Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority), the overseeing government body.

The day-to-day running of household of Faith are allocated as follows:

- a. Overall and spiritual development brother Henry Kong as minister
- b. Dealing with accounting firm brother Alfred Poon
- c. Keeping track of contributions etc
 - sister Annie Koh
- d. Worship/meeting projection and printing
 - Thng Tian Beng
- e. Office bearers for 2024-2025 brother Alfred Poon, sister June Dhanabalan and brother Ramesh Dhanabalan

Any faithful member of the Household of Faith who is regular at worships can be nominated and elected as an office bearer at our AGM. The Chairman oversees church activities, staff, secretary and treasurer, ensuring efficient and in compliance with local laws. The Secretary records the minutes of AGM, submission of reports and documents. The Treasurer oversees the weekly contribution and expenses, and is responsible to see to the audit


of the accounts.

Psalms 80:12 Why hast thou then broken down her hedges, so that all they which pass by the way do pluck her?


Like the Psalmist, we also cried out to God amidst our struggles.







Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.









Philippians 2:13 For it is God which work in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.


