MP3 Juice is a music download that allows you to search for music, listen to it in the app, and download songs for free so you can listen to songs offline. You can access millions of favorite songs by searching by their name or artists and albums. This free Android app will search through sources like YouTube and SoundCloud to find the music you're looking for. To download the MP3 Juice app, Android 4.0.3 and above is required. Users will need to download and install an APK on their Android device, not search the Google Play Store. The premise of MP3 Juice is along with a very simple and somewhat amateurish interface that consists of a search box and a source manager. You type users in the search query, select the resources they want to search for, and then click Search. Alternatively, you can also insert it into the video URL and click the search button to convert the video audio to an MP3 file. Music can be acquired through YouTube, SoundCloud, VK, Yandex, 4shared, PromoDJ and Archive, which access millions of songs and artists. When search results are returned, users can listen to the song directly in the app, most often by streaming video directly from the source website. Alternatively, you can download the song directly to your phone, save it to cloud storage (either Dropbox or Google Drive), or share it via Facebook. The application also contains an MP3 cutter that users can use to remove voiceless sections from MP3 files. We tried this feature and found that the resulting cut MP3 file just became unplayable after we downloaded it. Annoying pop-up and download fails Using MP3 Juice was sometimes a frustrating experience. We found many times that the download did not work. In this case, the application does not say that the download failed. Instead, the app pushes you into random messages or ads, many of which move user subscriptions. Some users may make an error as part of the MP3 download process and unwiedly sign up for something they don't want. We felt it was a bit dishonest and we didn't like how hard it was to leave this site and go back to the search engine page. The app includes other features such as online radio and music (available in the drop-down menu on the left side of the screen), but we found that they just didn't work. Links to entertainment news and Amazon are also accessible under a male-felt disconnect from the target app. The app didn't feel safe, with intrusion ad contexts and attempts to download more apps. It certainly wasn't safe to connect our cloud storage and Facebook profiles, so we didn't test that feature. Mp3 Juice is legal? Of course, the biggest problem with MP3 Juice is the question of whether downloading music using the application is or not. Unfortunately, it is legal different laws that apply in different jurisdictions and situations. For example, converting music from YouTube or other similar video platforms is against U.S. copyright law. In addition, YouTube considers downloading audio from its hosted video to be a violation of the Terms of Service, while SoundCloud offers its users advice on how to avoid unauthorized downloads and stream-rips of their content. On the other hand, much of the content available through the archive is covered by creative commons licenses. However, many of these licenses do not explicitly allow downloading an mp3 file for personal use. Ultimately, it's up to the user to decide if they feel comfortable using an app that has a dubious legal and moral standing. We recommend that you think about trying legitimate alternatives to MP3 Juice first. You can play YouTube music without violating the Streaming Site Terms of Use through YouTube Music. MP3 Juice makes a wide range of songs easy to search, play and download as MP3 files. The built-in player is simple, but works pretty well - although downloading songs is not without problems. The app's very basic and amateurish-looking interface, along with annoying advertising pop-ups, doesn't inspire confidence in its security. Should you download it? The use of MP3 Juice to convert video into audio in order to download as an MP3 file poses vague legal and moral questions about copyright and intellectual property. MP3 files are generally available on the Internet for downloading to your computer or transferring to audio players such as an iPod or other music device. It takes only a few steps to download and save an mp3 file to your computer. Visit one of the many websites that sell MP3 files--Amazon.com, Walmart.com, iTunes.com, Napster.com and MP3Download.net are some great. Most of them require you to register a user account. Most sites charge a fee for downloading MP3 files. Membership usually allows you to download a certain number of MP3 files each month. Files can be purchased with a credit card or gift card. MP3 files are generally intended for personal, non-commercial use. You can burn files to a compact disc, play them on your computer, or transfer them to an MP3 player. Like Limewire, the program is very easy to use and gives you unlimited free access to millions of music and video files. Download and install the software from the MP3 Rocket website, but be careful. The basic version of the program is free, but you can pay up to \$34 for the version if you want more than the basic ability to download and share files. Click one of the icons in the left panel to select the type of file you want to download, or select All Types. Type the name of the file you want to find in the box in the left panel, and click search or select one of the categories from the toolbar over the top that allows you to access more popular music files. Select the genre of music you want from the list in the left panel, and the names of the artists and songs appear in the right panel. Double-click the artist and song you want, and the software will start searching the network for all files containing this information. Then they appear as a list in the right panel. Click the version you want to download and the program will download it to your computer. Your download time may be affected by connecting the computer hosting the file. Do not click continue on the home page of MP3 Rocket if you want a free version of the software. Clicking on Continue will bring you to the sign up page for the Pro version, which can cost you up to \$35. To get the free version, click on the word download at the bottom of the page. Beware of copyrighted files or licensed files that may be available on your network. Because it's a file sharing service, many of them might be listed. Downloading without paying for them is illegal.
