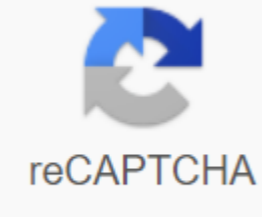

Bacchiocchi (29 января 1938 г. — 20 декабря 2008 г.) был автором адвентистов седьмого дня и богословом, наиболее известным за его работу в субботу в христианстве, особенно в исторической работе «От субботы до воскресенья», основанной на докторской диссертации Папского григорианского университета. Bacchiocchi защитил действительность праздников Господа, расположенный в Левит 23, он написал две книги на эту тему. Он также был известен в церкви адвентистов седьмого дня за его оппозицию року и современной христианской музыке, ювелирным изделиям, празднованию Рождества и Пасхи, некоторым стандартам одежды и алкоголю. Биография Bacchiocchi родился в Риме, Италия 20 января 1938 года. Позже он получил степень бакалавра гуманитарных наук в богословии в колледже Ньюболд в Англии, за которым последовали магистр искусств и бакалавр богословия в Университете Эндрюса в Мичигане, США; в 1964 году. Бакиокки переехал со своей женой Анной в Куйеру, район Шашамане, Эфиопия, где он читал лекции в and stories. In 1969 they returned to Rome, where Bazkiokki studied at the Pontifical Gregorian University. It was the first neocolylite to be adopted since its inception in the 16th century. In 1974, he completed a doctorate in church history on the decline of Saturday observance in the early Christian Church, based on his research in Vatican libraries. Bakkiokki taught at the University of Andrews Department of Religion from 1974 until his retirement in 2000. He taught theology and church history. He regularly has presented seminars around the world and has written many self-described books and articles on biblical topics. He was married to Anna Gandin Bakkiokki. They had three children. In May 2007, Bakkiokki announced that he had developed liver and colon cancer. Eventually, he died of stage 4 liver cancer, shortly after midnight, on Saturday, December 20, 2008, the day before what would have been his 47th wedding anniversary. He was with three children and a wife. Impact In 1977 Bacchiocchi published from Saturday to Sunday, documenting the historic transition from Saturday Saturday to Sunday in an early Christian church due to social, pagan and political factors, as well as lowering standards for the day. The book influenced the wider academic community outside of Adventism as well as Adventism. Prior to their work, seventh-day Adventists focused on the role of Pope or Roman Emperor Constantine I in the transition from Saturday to Sunday, with Constantine's law declaring Sunday a day of rest for those who are not engaged in agriculture. After Bakkiokki's work, The Adventists stressed that the transition from Saturday to Sunday was a more gradual process. Bacchiocchi was also influential in the worldwide Church of God (and its offshoots), which supported Saturday storage until 1995, as well as other Saturday storage groups. Bacchiocchi's beliefs supported conservative seventh-day Adventist lifestyle habits such as the vegetarian diet, abstinence from alcohol, coffee and tea; and avoiding rock music in church services. In one bulletin, he presented a hypothesis, expanding the Adventist (and historical Protestant) teaching that the Antichrist is a papacy to also include Islam, which he said created many hate letters. Controversy over academic awards in the 2000s was some of controversy over Bakkiokka's claim that he received honors (Latin for higher honors), the Pope's Gold Medal and the official Roman Catholic imprimatur (Latin for let it be printed) for his doctorate at the Pontifical Gregorian University. The official letter stated that Bakkiokki had not received these awards. By 2007, both sides agreed that he had received the Pope's Gold Medal with distinction Doctoral program; and only with honors for the Doctor himself. Bacchiocchi defended his actions by claiming the difference between Licentia and Doctoratus is small and would not be understood by most English speakers. Jesuit conspiracy theory Fringe Adventists are suspicious of Bacchiocchi because he studied at the University of Gregorian, claiming that he was a secret Jesuit for the Vatican. In addition, Alberto Rivera argued that the endorsement from Saturday to Sunday was given as a ploy to win over the Adventists, both for similar gimmicks with other churches. Rivera was a fundamentalist Christian who claimed to be a former Jesuit priest, but this point and many other allegations were discredited by the majority of the authors. Bacchiocchi's publications were owned by a small non-Aunitiziam publishing house called Biblical Perspectives, through which he self-published 16 of his own books, as well as a book by Graham Bradford.
