He was an assistant at several parishes in NJ, and then pastor of St. Theresa of the Child Jesus in Linden, NJ. He was appointed vice-rector of SS. Cyril and Methodius Seminary by Archbishop Maida, and held the position for 5 years. In 2011 he was appointed Director of the Friends of St. John Paul II *Be Not Afraid* Center in the USA by Archbishop John Myers at the request of Cardinal Dziwisz, and raised funds for the John Paul II *Be Not Afraid* Center in Krakow, Poland. He was elected by the presbyterate to be President of the Polish Clergymen's Society and Dean of Union Southeast Deanery of the Archdiocese of Newark. He was appointed the Representative of the Polish Ethnic group at the Conference of the Catholic Bishops of the USA in 2017. Chancellor & CEO of the Orchard Lake Schools.
