

Its development was entrusted to the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA), which in 2004 came out with a 146.5 km master plan with several lines. Due to various issues that range from paralysis policies (EPC vs. PPP, Metro Rail vs. Monorail) to environmental issues, MMRDA has so far only managed to develop one metro line in the suburb connecting Versus - Adery East - Ghatkopar. A new 118-kilometre master plan was approved in 2015, and the then incumbent government provided a much-needed impetus for the development of two lines: East - Aheri East (Red Line) - Dahisar East - D.N. Nagar (Yellow Line) in addition to The Kaffa Parade - BKC - - Colony (Aqua Line). In June 2019, a new nodal agency called Maha Mumbai Metro Operations Corporation (MMMOCL) was established to operate and maintain all OF MUMBAI's MMRDA-owned metro lines. In September 2019, MMRDA unveiled a new 337 km master plan for the Maha Mumbai metro network consisting of 10 lines (17 sections in total). Delhi Metro Rail Corporation has provided its services as interim general counsel to perform most of the lines.
