Baby Gear Checklist



What you need for your Nanny Share



Both Families

••••• **Don't stress about** too many added costs. You should already have most of what you need for a nanny share in your own home.

- Diapers
- Baby wipes
- Ointment / cream
- Extra clothes
- Swaddling blankets or sleep sack
- Lovey
- Pacifiers (with a storage container)
- Bibs
- Extra bottles
- Breastmilk, milk, formula, baby food/solids
- Favorite books
- Favorite toys
- Sunscreen (if age-appropriate)
- Diaper bag (packed and ready for the nanny to take to the park and other outings)
- Double stroller



CozyKin Pro-Tip



A double stroller is essential for a nanny share!

Your nanny needs a way to safely transport two littles ones to the park, playdates and fun museum outings.

..... PURCHASING OPTIONS

1 One family purchases the stroller

We've seen families who are planning on having two children opt to take on the cost.

2 The families split the cost



If only one family is hosting, then the stroller can be kept their home. If you're alternating homes, make sure you coordinate where the stroller needs to be each day!

Drop-Off Family Only

- **In our experience**, the host family is usually happy to share everyday items. But the drop-off family will need to purchase and pack some essentials.

- Bag to transport items needed for daily care
- Portable crib (pack 'n play, travel bassinet, etc)
- Sheets
- Bin to hold extra diapers, wipes and clothes
- Sound or white noise machine (if applicable)
- Portable high chair or booster seat
- Silverware, plates and cups (if you're particular, it's best to pack your own)
- Dish soap for bottles (again, if you're particular)



CozyKin Pro-Tip

There's no need to purchase full-sized versions of a high chair or crib.

Travel versions work great for a nanny share!

Host-Family Only

- **Your home is likely already stocked for your little one's needs.** But there are a few things you should make sure you have on hand and available for the nanny.

- Fire extinguisher
- First aid kits (one for the home, one for the stroller)
- Nail file
- Thermometer
- Bath tub, baby soap and towels (for occasional use)
- Sound or white noise machine (if applicable)



CozyKin Pro-Tip

Make sure you provide plenty of storage space for your partner family to store their items.

Ideally, you can make space in both the nursery and kitchen.
