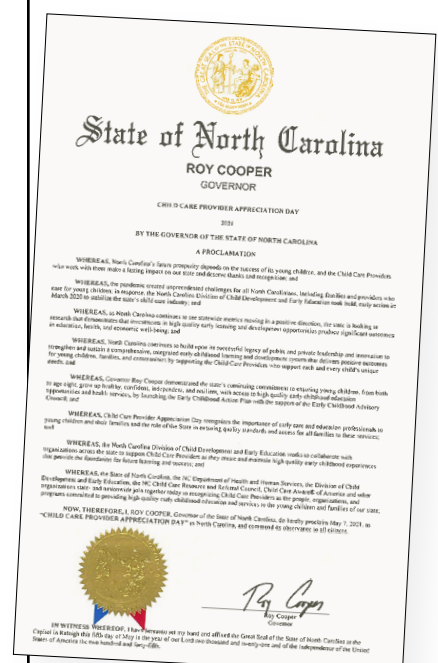

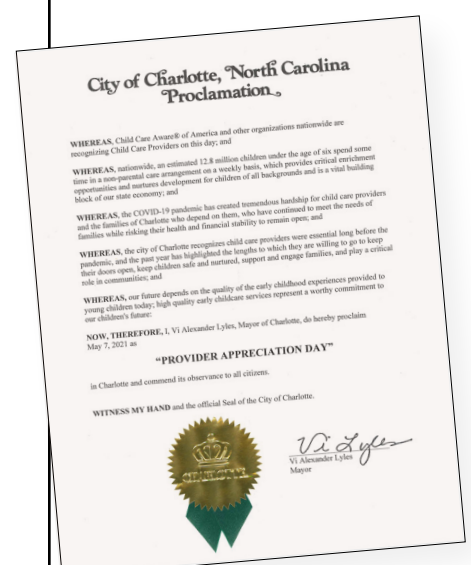
North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper has issued a proclamation officially recognizing May 7th as Child Care Provider Appreciation Day!
