What does thankfulness look like?

Old Testament: Sacrifice of Thanksgiving

An optional peace offering that included both animal and bread offering which was shared between God, the priest, and the worshiper.\

- Leviticus 22:29 And when you offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving to the LORD, offer *it* of your own free will.
- Psalm 116:16-17 O LORD, truly I *am* Your servant; I *am* Your servant, the son of Your maidservant; You have loosed my bonds. ¹⁷ I will offer to You the sacrifice of thanksgiving, And will call upon the name of the LORD.

New Testament: Sacrifice of Praise

An offering of our words of praise to God, giving thanks to Him, and living a life of thankfulness, doing and sharing with others.

- Hebrews 13:15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of *our* lips, giving thanks to His name.
- Colossians 2:6-7 As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.
