Soon after, she unintentionally jumps time when leaving the house. At first, Gwen doubts her leap into time, since her cousin Charlotte Charlotte has always been intended to have inherited the time travel gene that is transmitted by females in their families. Charlotte had been prepared for this duty all her life, and loved Gwyneth for ruining her life plans. Gwen experiences two other uncontrolled jumps through time, during the third of which she witnesses herself, or a double sister, kissing a boy she never met at a prom in the 1700s. The chronograph is also the second made, the first having been stolen by Lucy, the daughter of Uncle Harry of Gwyneth, and Paul, younger brother of Falk de Villiers. Gwyneth is charged with the arrogant and disapproved Gideon de Villiers to watch her. Soon after, Gwyneth was to meet the founder of the lodge, the powerful Count Saint-Germain. For unexplained reasons to Gwen, her mother is strictly against the meeting. Despite this, Gwen goes to meet the Count, hoping that she might find answers. However, Gwen has only other questions, and is also wary of the Count, who is supposed to possess telepathy. After the meeting, the stagecoach of their car is instructed by someone unknown to take the two to a park, where they are quickly attacked by three men. Gideon and Gwen keep them away, then return to their present days. The next day, Gwen is called back to the Lodge, where she is surprised to find that she is needed to talk to someone in the past, her great-great-grandmother, and the eighth time traveler, Margaret Tilney, so that her blood would be read in the chronograph, since Gideon had made two attempts to collect Margaret's blood, but both times she had refused. Both travel back in time to the time When Margaret awaits them, despite the exact date that has been set in the chronograph to travel back in time being kept secret. Lucy and Paul make their appearance, urging Gwyneth to trust them, and to ensure that the blood of all twelve time travelers is not read in the chronograph, lest the great event that will occur that can cause more destruction than good. threatens Lucy with a gun, and makes her escort and Gwyneth out of the house, and as the two run away, she tells Gwen to look up At The Green Rider. The two escape to a nearby church, next door, a confessional cabin, where Gideon, unexpectedly, kisses Gwen. Sapphire Blue In the prologue, Lucy and Paul return to watch Hamlet the play in 1602 when they witnessed a murder. In the present, Gideon just kissed Gwen when they are disturbed by a gargoye demon named Xemerius, whom only Gwen can see. They return to their own time and travel by taxi to the Lodge. Along the way, Gideon reveals that he lives alone in an apartment and after his father's death, his mother remarried a wealthy French man, and the two moved to France and had another child named Raphael, Gideon's younger brother. He also reveals that he finds the gene of time travel more a curse, because it means that he can only travel outside England in the company of the Guardians and the chronograph. Xemerius follows them to the Temple, where Gwen allows her to follow her around, believing that he will come useful for information. Gideon and Gwen meet with members of the Inner Circle to discuss how Lucy and Paul knew about their visit to Lady Tilney. All members, except Mr. George and Gideon, suspect Gwen of telling them, although there is no evidence. Gwen was sent to 1948, the same year as the London Olympics, to fill her time quota for the day. After landing in 1948, despite Mr. George's assurance that no one would be there, Gwen met Lord Lucas Montrose, her grandfather in the alchemical laboratory. Lucas explains that Gwen gave him a note to meet in this room. While speaking, Gwen explains that she is her granddaughter, that Lucy and Paul stole the chronograph and went to the year 1912, and about her current situation of being the Ruby in the time travel circle, her suspicions about Count Saint-Germain, her confusion about the secret of the chronograph, and her feelings towards Gideon. The two promised to meet again, in late 1956, and Lucas promised to store a key in the bricks, as well as the password. The next day, at breakfast, Lady Arista says gwen that Charlotte will now teach her to be a suitable time traveler, much to Gwen's chagrin. After school, Gwen and Charlotte are taken by Mr. Marley to the Temple where Gwen meets Giordano, who has an immediate dislike for her. Gwen learns dance while being asked about the story, all in preparation for an evening that Gwen must attend on the orders of Count Saint-Germain. After lessons, she is brought home by Gideon who is upset that Raphael ran away from home, although the next day at school, Lesley, Cynthia, and Gwen discover that he would be at St. Lennox High with them. On the way to the Temple, Gwen receives shocking news from Xemerius that Gideon, passed away earlier in the day, was hit in the head by someone and left unconscious, but later she discovers that he is fine. Ok. Dance and history lessons, she is sent to run off in 1956 where she meets Lucas under the disguise of being her cousin, Hazel, and the two go to a café. Lucas tells him that he discovered that flowing into the past, then using the chronograph to flow further into the past was quite possible, and Lucas sent Lucy and Paul to 1602 to see Hamlet. When they returned, they told Lucas of the murder they witnessed, and are shocked to find that it was Count Saint-Germain who murdered Lancelot de Villiers, the first traveller, and his ancestor. The two return to the Temple, and before Gwen disappears, he tells her that the Count had enemies in the Florentine Covenant, that he had private documents not recorded in the Annals, and that reading the twelve of the traveller's blood in the chronograph was not the only thing that had to be done to reveal his secret. After traveling back in time, Gideon is there, wondering why Gwen was smelling smoke, but she's trying to play off that she was smoking. Gwen invites Lesley over, and Mr. Bernard brings Lord Montrose's copy of The Green Rider, which has a series of numbers on a piece of paper; a code that Lesley breaks, but can't make sense of the decoded message. The next day, Gwen and Gideon run away, and Gideon reveals that he believed he had been hit in the head by Gwen, but knows she would do nothing to hurt him. The next day, it was the evening, and after travelling to church and having passed away, they met Rakoczy, who took them to the evening hosted by Lord and Lady Brompton. Gideon is led by Lavinia Rutland and Gwen befriends Lady Brompton and another woman, while having an immediate dislike for Mr. Merchant, who groped her, and Lady Lavinia, who flirts with Gideon. After accidentally drinking punch tinged with alcohol, Gwen sings the song Memory from the musical Cats, with Gideon on piano. Later, she meets the Count again, as well as Lord Alastair, a man who descends from Conte di Madrone who founded the Florentine Alliance as a way to rid the earth of demons, which he believes to be the time travelers. The ghost of Conte di Madrone behind Lord Alastair cries curses on travelers, in addition to making several threats. Gideon and Gwen leave the party to go to church and return to the present, although Gideon is angry that Gwen drank the punch. Lesley sleeps more and both looking for clues to The Green Rider, with no results. The next day, Raphael correctly guesses the series of numbers and letters is a kind of GPS code, and while they are left to understand, Gwen heads to the Temple to pass on the eve of the evening to meet the Count. After sending Gideon with Lady Lavinia, the Count is delighted see that Gwen fell in love with Gideon, declaring that women in love were much easier to control, and commends Gideon for her work. Shocked, angry and Gwen confronts Gideon about it after they have flowed to the present again, to which he denies pretending to fall in love with her, but does not deny deceiving her. Gwen leaves the Temple, angry and heartbroken. In the epilogue, Paul meets Lord Alastair, who gives him the Count's secret papers in exchange for the reproductive trees of the male and female lineage of the time travellers. Paul refuses to give the papers, claiming that Alastair broke their promise by not coming alone and bringing his men. The three duels, but Paul is seriously wounded in the arm, and Gideon suddenly appears, saving Paul, but not the documents on the 600,500 trees. Before Paul disappears, he urges Gideon, who truly loves Gwen, to read the secret documents and prevent the circle from being closed in order to prevent Gwen from dying. Emerald Green After the events of Sapphire Blue, Gwyneth explains her grief to Lesley, who sympathizes with her, but also kindly reminds her that she has a mission to do. With Raphael's help, the coordinates that were left after the numbers found in Lord Montrose's copy of The Green Rider indicate that Gwyneth's house is where the treasure is probably hidden. Xemerius confirmed this after taking stock of the house and discovering that there was a chest between the walls behind the painting of one of Gwyneth's ancestors. Nick wakes up and notices Gwen talking to Xemerius about the hidden treasure, and agrees to help. The two come down to remove the painting, to be caught by Mr. Bernard, who explains that a chisel and a hammer were necessary to pierce the bricks, for it was he who hid the treasure in his grandfather's name, and agreed to do so that evening, when Lady Arista and Glenda were gone. At school, Cynthia invites Lesley, Charlotte and Gwen to her party, although all her guests are forced to wear green, and Lesley rejects Raphael's attempts to help more with the mysteries, although Gwen rightly guesses that Lesley loves Raphael. After school, Gideon meets Gwyneth at the Temple and offers to stay friends with her, which she refuses and walks away from. After having passed again in 1956, she meets her grandfather, Lucas, again, and the two try to work on what he hid in the chest behind the bricks. Eventually, Lucas realizes that this is the first chronograph, and Gwyneth realizes that with her, she can travel back in time whenever she wants, but with some limit, and Lucas takes her to the Dragon Room and explains how to work the chronograph, and uses the chronograph to have Gwyneth travel even further back in time to visit Lady Tilney , who was waiting for him. Lady Tilney gives him a knitted pig, which Gwyneth later gives to her sister, give him no advice or warning, much to Gwyneth's chagrin. After travelling back to the present, Gideon finds her and tries to patch things up, but always refuses and goes home. After dinner, Mr. Bernard starts hammering through the bricks, while Charlotte is busy playing Scrabble with Maddy. The chest is highlighted, and the key, which Gwyneth found after having passed a few days earlier before meeting Lucas the first time, is the same one Gwyneth had given Lesley. Upon opening the chest, the first chronograph is found, which is given to Gwyneth. That same night, Gwyneth moved to meet Lucas in the past again, and although he is now married to Arista and they got Harry, he still doesn't have much information about Lucy and Paul. The two agree to meet again much closer to Gwyneth's birth date, when he is Grand Master of the Lodge, and when he has more time to gather information about Lucy and Paul. After returning to the present, she is caught by Charlotte, who demands to know what she is wearing, but after Mr. Bernard has intercepted before she can forcefully discover it, Charlotte agrees to know what Gwyneth is doing. Gwyneth makes sure the chronograph is hidden inside a wall she tore in the back of her closet, stuffed inside a stuffed animal crocodile, before she falls asleep. The next day, Charlotte is reported to be ill, although Gwyneth suspects that she faked her illness to search her room, but later in the day, Gwyneth claims she caught the cold as well to avoid going to the bullet that was supposed to take place that day. At the Temple, the meeting with the Count at the ball is postponed, and Gwyneth runs away and is sent home. That same night, it flows again, but is almost taken by Glenda and Charles who, at the time, lived in his room. She meets her grandfather who gives him the book Anna Karenina, although the middle of the book is all the information he is able to collect since the last time she visited him and the first and last page of 300 are the authentic

text. After returning to the present, she is again intercepted by Charlotte, who claims she is closer to finding out what Gwyneth is hiding. The next morning, while Gwyneth was resting from his false cold, Mr. Marley, and another man named Mr. Brewer, after a pipe from Charlotte, entered Gwyneth's room and discovered the chest in which the chronograph was hidden, creating quite a mess and a din, but after they left, Gwyneth assures Maddy that the chronograph was moved and the only thing they would find in the chest was his by Jane Austen. Although Mr. Marley, who later picked up Gwyneth to go to the Temple to run, apologized, Mr. Whitman was suspicious. As it flows, accompanied him, also wondering why Charlotte suspected her of having the chronograph, although Gwyneth lies and said it was used as a card table for texas hold 'em. Gideon later revealed that he had obtained Elaine Burghley's blood, and that he had suspicions about the Reasons. He then asks Gwyneth if she was willing to let someone die if there was a cure for all the diseases of humanity. Gwyneth replies that even a human life seems too. a high price to pay, but from a practical point of view, it would allow it. The next day, Gwyneth is over her cold, and she is ready to meet the Count again at the ball held by Lord and Lady Pympoole-Bothame, James' parents, at her school, but in the past it was their home, and it is revealed that Charlotte lost more of her credibility after stealing Lesley's backpack , calling the Lodge many times and looking for Gwyneth's room, but still not finding the chronograph. While being led by Mr. George to flow, he reveals the reason why they must go to the ball is to lure Lord Alastair, as well as the traitor among the Guardians, so that he can be accurately recorded in the Annals. After running away, Gideon tells the count that he got Lady Tilney's blood, and then leads Gwyneth to dance. During the dance, Lady Lavinia dances with Gideon while Gwyneth meets James and urges her to meet her in Hyde Park to talk about her horse Hector. After running away from Gideon's rebuke of the attraction of attention, she meets a drunken Rakoczy who tries to make her drink something strong, but is thwarted by Gideon. Gwyneth flees again into an empty room, and Gideon follows her, trying to assure her that he has no feelings for Lady Lavinia. While fighting, Gwyneth discovers her self-spent watching them from her third journey through uncontrolled time, and embraces Gideon as a distraction. After his younger departure, Lord Alastair, Lord Alcott and Lady Lavinia cornered them in the room where it was revealed that Lord Alcott was the traitor among the Guardians, and Lord Alastair paid a good sum of money to Alcott and Lavinia to assist him in his plans. Lavinia managed to remove Gideon's hidden weapon, and both are left defenseless. Lavinia is fired and Alcott and Alastair fight Gideon and Gwyneth. Although Gideon manages to pin Alastair's arm to the wall with a sword and Gwyneth kills Alcott, Alastair manages to execute his sword through Gwyneth. After a brief sensation of becoming a ghost, Gwyneth finds herself in the present, and apart from a scratch, she is unharmed. She is sent home, but Gideon shows up during supper asking to see Gwyneth, and the two go up to her room, where Gideon expresses her relief at finding her alive, and reveals that, according to the papers given to her by Paul, she is technically immortal, that is how she survived the attack, and that to get the philosopher's stone , the secret of the chronograph the diseases of humanity, someone must die, which is Gwyneth. Lesley introduces himself later, and after deciding Gideon no longer needs to be excluded, explains how Lucas, Lucy and Paul discovered that the Count intends to get philosopher's stone and make themselves immortal. However, Gwyneth must take her own life for the prophecies to come true, and to allow the Count to become immortal, and she is supposed to do so because of Gideon. The next day, when Gwyneth is brought back to the past, along with her mother, who has also been invited, she accidentally hears her mother being interrogated by the Inner Circle. After tracking down the midwife who allegedly gave birth to Gwyneth, it is revealed that Lucy was the one who gave birth to Gwyneth, and Grace gave the midwife a large sum of money to record the wrong date on the birth certificate and say that Grace was the one who gave birth. Lucy and Paul were forced to leave Gwyneth behind, and Grace and Nicholas raised her as one of their own. After hearing the shocking news, Gwyneth and Gideon escape into the chronograph room and flow, despite the need to complete the Black Tourmaline and Sapphire operation. After traveling back to the present, Gideon is taken to meet the Inner Circle while Gwyneth and her mother clear things up. After meeting Mrs. Rossini to collect green suits for Cynthia's party that night, and some 1912 clothes, Gwyneth takes Gideon to the roof where she hid the chronograph, knowing that Charlotte is afraid of heights. Gideon has his blood read in the chronograph, and with the now complete circle, the philosopher's stone is revealed, and Gideon hides the salty substance. The two go to church, change in their 1912 clothes, and flow to meet Lady Tilney, Lucy and Paul, where they try to find a plan to keep the circle on the second chronograph to be closed, now that they know the truth, and they tell themselves that the Count is somehow pulling strings from the past to get the Guardians to make his bidding. Later, after returning to the present, they meet Lesley and Raphael at the party, where they find their classmates in a drunken manner after the punch is stung with vodka, and Charlotte, also drunk, sings karaoke and reveals everything she knows about Count Saint-Germain and the time travelers. Gideon returns home while Lesley, Raphael and Gwyneth return to Gideon's apartment to find a plan to find out how to prevent the circle from being closed on the second chronograph, and the possibility that the Count still lives in the present, disguised as someone else. The next day, Lesley, Gideon, Raphael and Gwyneth went to the subway tracks, and Gideon and Gwyneth s rescued themselves to try to prevent the younger Gideon from delivering the letter on Operation Black Tourmaline and Sapphire. They bump into Gideon's younger self and knock him out, and Dr. Harrison appears, assuring them will not deliver the letter under Lady Tilney's instructions. They return to the present, then go back in time and meet James in Hyde Park where Gideon gives him the Vaccine. They return to the present, they go to the Temple to flow and meet the count. Gwyneth stays behind to talk to the Count while Gideon is fired to carry out the operation. However, Gwyneth is poisoned by Rakoczy, and after traveling back to the present, it is revealed that Mr. Whitman is Count Saint-Germain, but in cosmetic surgery. After Gwyneth's birth, the Count began to grow old, as he was the one who was previously immortal, and in order to successfully become immortal again with the Philosopher's Stone, Gwyneth had to take his own life on love. Lucas came close to discovering the truth, which is why Marley senior had to poison him, and Lucy and Paul, who also discovered the truth, had to hide with the chronograph in 1912. Mr. Whitman held the Guardians at gunpoint and locked them in the chronograph room after the circle closed on the second chronograph, and planned to kill Gideon once he returned to the present to force Gwyneth to take his own life. [3] Characters [4][5][6] Gwyneth Shepherd Gwyneth (Gwendolyn in the original) Sophie Elizabeth Shepherd is the protagonist of 16 years of the series. She is the daughter of Grace and Nicolas Shepherd, born on October 7, 1994, but in the third book, Emerald Green, it was revealed that her real parents are Lucy and Paul. She grew up believing that her birthday was October 8 instead, which made her think that she was not the one who had inherited the gene from her family's time travel. Although, as she later discovered, she inherited the time travel gene on her cousin Charlotte, and is the last of the twelve time travelers, known as ruby. She is physically different from the rest of the Montroses with straight dark hair and blue eyes. Gwyneth is said to be very clumsy, always accidentally dipping the tie of her school uniform into her lunch and tripping over her own feet. He was born in 1992 and is 19 years old. He has an apartment in but has lived with his uncle Falk de Villiers since the age of eleven. Her father died and her mother moved to France with her new boyfriend Mr Bertelin with her other youngest son Raphael. Gideon attended a boarding school in Greenwich, where he was captain of the school's polo team and is now studying medicine at the University of London. With Charlotte, he was prepared to travel back in time all his life, which earned him to be very talented and intelligent, in addition to being arrogant. Underestimating Gwyneth leads her to behave disrespectfully towards her at first, because he thinks she is not good enough to travel back in time. However, as he believed that Gwyneth is suitable for time travel, he tried to make Gwyneth fall in love with him to make it predictable. But, as the series progresses Gideon warms up to Gwyneth substantially and ends up falling in love with herself. Grace Shepherd (née Montrose) Gwyneth, Nick, and Caroline's mother. Like all Montroses, she has curly red hair and blue eyes. Her behaviour is often very mysterious and she knows more than she lets go. She also helped Lucy and Paul escape with the stolen chronograph by letting them stay for several months at her home in Durham, where she had lived with her husband and children until her husband's death. Charlotte's cousin Montrose Gwyneth and Glenda's daughter, who would have inherited the gene from time travel in the first place, were prepared for her role all her life. She is very talented in everything she does and is described as exceptionally beautiful and charming. She is also very arrogant because of the high praise for her abilities since she was young. She has a grudge against Gwyneth for taking all the attention away from her and gwyneth talks down every chance she gets. She's also in love with Gideon. Lesley Hay Also known as leslie in German and in some translations, Libby. Gwyneth's best friend, who also attends St. Lennox High School. She has freckles and blonde hair and is the only one outside Gwyneth's family who knows the secret of time travel. At first, she helps Gwyneth uncover the mystery, gathering information from the Internet and books. She is very intelligent and helpful, and encourages Gwyneth. She lives with her parents and her dog Bertie in an apartment in North Kensington. Falk de Villiers Gideon's uncle and grand master of the Lodge. He is described as looking like a wolf, having amber eyes and dark hair streaked with the white of old age. He had been in a relationship with Grace when they were younger and still holds a small grudge against her for choosing on him. He still seems to have feelings for her. Lucy Montrose Lucy is the daughter of Gwyneth's uncle, Harry. She's Gwyneth's cousin. She ran away from home at the age of 17 after falling in love with her time traveling partner, Paul de Villiers. Villiers. together they have discovered the mystery of what happens when the blood of the twelve time travelers is fed to the chronograph. Wanting to prevent this at all costs, they escaped the year 1912 with one of the chronographs. For this reason, they will never be able to go back to their own time and are stuck in the past forever. Lucy is 18 years old and is the tenth of the circle, also known as Sapphire or lynx. She has red hair and blue eyes like all Montrose and is very small. In the third book, Emerald Green, Gwyneth discovers that Lucy is her mother. Younger brother of Paul de Villiers Falk and ninth in the circle, he is the jewel of the Black Tourmaline or the wolf. With Lucy, whom he had fallen in love with, he stole the chronograph and escaped to the past, never being able to return. Like his brother, he has dark hair and amber eyes. In the third book, Emerald Green, Gwyneth discovers that Paul de Villiers is her father. Count Saint-Germain Born in 1703, he is the founder of the Lodge and was the first traveller to invent the chronograph, allowing him and future time travellers to prevent uncontrolled jumps in time. Miroslav Alexander Leopold Rakoczy Also known as the Black Leopard, he is the count and is described as having black eyes and lifeless. He is known to have experimented with various medications and comes from Transylvania. Mr. Bernard The butler of the Household. It is later revealed that he is a descendant of the second child of Lucy and Paul (Gwyneth's blood brother), who was born in 1919 while living under the original name of Mr and Mrs. Bernard. James August Peregrin Pympoole-Bothame The Ghost of School who is Gwyneth's friend. He was born on March 31, 1762, but died at the age of 21 from smallpox. He is not aware that he is dead and constantly believes that he is just dreaming. Mr. Thomas George A member of the Inner Circle of the Lodge, and one of the only members gwyneth loves and trusts to some extent. He was his grandfather's assistant and later his best friend, which is why he supported Gwyneth when she and her mother first came to the Lodge. Dr. Jakob White The Lodge doctor and also a member of the Inner Circle. He still wears black suits and is exceptionally rude and dark towards everyone, due to the death of his young son several years before the events of the first novel. Because of Gwyneth's ability to see the spirits, she sometimes sees the ghost of her son, Robert, near her father. Xemerius The demon that follows Gwyneth around after he witnessed and Gideon kissed in the church, he was haunting. Although it is called a demon, it is described more accurately as a cat ghost that can speak. It becomes very useful for spying on people to get information for Gwyneth because she is the only one who is able to see it. Lord Alistair The arch-enemy of Count Saint-Germain who is the leader of the Florentine Alliance, dedicated to the eradication of the time travel line that he believes to be demons. Lord Alistair is followed by the ghost of his ancestor, di Madrone, who founded the Florentine Alliance. Only Gwyneth can see the Count with his special ability. The original version of the film is in German, but the subtitles were developed in English. Rubinrot was nominated for the International Film Music Critics Award (IFMCA) for best original score for an action/adventure/thriller film in 2013, but did not win. Sapphire Blue Rubinrot's sequel, Saphirblau, was also transformed into a film, released in Germany on December 18, 2014. Many actors, actresses, producers and screenwriters are the same as those in the first film. The film was released earlier in Luxembourg and Austria on 14 and 15 August 2014 respectively. Like Rubinrot, Saphirblau was shot mainly in Germany. Unlike Rubinrot, Saphirblau departs considerably from the plot of the novel, as does its sequel, Smaragdgron.
