We have had a busy week continuing our learning about Diwali. The children were investigating the resources on the light table, using loose parts to make rangoli pattens, trying chapattis for snack, exploring light and dark with the torches and dens, decorating our diva lamps, drawing Mendhi patterns, painting fireworks on the easels and listening to the story of The Runaway Chapatti. The children also enjoyed using the wooden blocks and foam blocks to create roads, towers and pathways, dig for treasure in the garden, repot some flowers to brighten our garden and blue group made some fantastic artwork of the initial letter of their names. 
