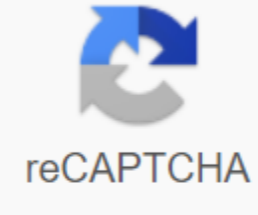

For example, with most models your TV should be less than 130 pounds (59 kg). 2 Remove the stand from the back of the TV. This is usually slipped off or unscrewed. Later, you'll use these screw holes to install the TV. 3 Poll whether the back of the TV is flat or curved. You will attach TV brackets with different processes depending on this function. 4 Find hardware bags labeled M4, M5, M6 and M8. These are different-sized screws and washers designed to be installed on any flat panel TV. You also have to find a hex key that will install the screws. 5 Find left and right TV brackets. They are usually labeled B and C and have holes that allow you to set brackets for many different TVs. They will run vertically down the back of the TV over the existing screw holes. Make sure you set the left and right braces in the same holes so that the TV will fit right into the mountain. 6 Attach the TV braces on either side of the flat-support TV, using either the M4 and M5 pucks, or the M6 or M8 washers and screws. Check the kits to see what fits into the screw holes. Use a hexagonal key to tighten the screws. The installation order goes to the bracket, the washer, and then the screw. The M4/M5 kit usually includes 12mm screws. The M6/M8 includes 12, 16 or 22 mm screws. 7 Attach the TV braces to both sides of the curved TV with the speysers, which have also been included in the M4, M5, M6 or M8 packages. Place an opening over the screw hole on the TV and then attach the puck, bracket, other puck and screw. Use hexagonal to tighten the screws. 8 Find out if your TV includes horizontal grilles. They are usually included in models that include hand assembly. If this happens, slide them through the television brackets horizontally and fasten them with 9/16-inch phillips head screws and a screwdriver. 1 1 Your stud wall. Use the edge to the edge of the stud for the best results. Choose a stud where you want your TV to be installed securely. Use wall anchors if you install a TV mountain in a concrete wall. Do not place the Rocketfish mount in drywall. It should be supported by a stud. 2 Hammer the pilot nail into the stud to make sure you have chosen a stable location. 3 Line up the wall plate with the area where you want to mount the TV. Place the level above it and adjust until it is level. Spot the place where you will screw it with a pencil. 4 Drill small pilot holes in these places using an electric drill. 5 Place the wall plate over the holes. Place the puck in front of each hole and then lag the bolt. Tighten the lag bolt into place with the socket key. Be careful not to over tighten the lag bolts or you run the risk of damaging the studs and TV. 6 Insert the assembling of your hands on the wall plate if your Rocketfish mountain includes one. Slide it from top to bottom and then attach the screw cover to the hex key. 1 Lift the TV and tilt the top to the wall if you

have a tilt model without assembling your hand. Slide the brackets onto the wall plate until you hear a sonic click. You may need help to pick up the TV and find the right accommodation. 2 Alternately lift the TV and slide it to the side on the wall plate if it has a hand assembly. The hand should fit under the metal tabs. Wrap your hand with screws at the top and bottom of the bracket. 3 Adjust the angle up and down on the sloping model. Adjust the angle from side to side with a hand assembly model. You will need to use your hex key to adjust some angles at the arm assembly.
