*Since its founding in 2000, the **Sun City Hiking Club** has participated in trail projects which benefit numerous hike destinations managed by local entities. We recognize that without the natural resources available at nearby parks, preserves and greenbelts, our group outdoor adventures would not be possible.*

*In 2019, Hiking Club volunteers were excited to be invited by the Williamson County Parks Department to assist with trail development projects underway at the fledgling **River Ranch County Park**. Since then, a team of club members has worked with park management on a variety of tasks. Our assignments have ranged from mapping and clearing hiking trails to assisting with enhancement projects along nature paths and in campgrounds and public areas.*

*We also assist park management and the **Friends of River Ranch** by designing suggested hike routes within the RRCP trail system and by leading guided hikes along park trails when requested.*

*Other joint efforts with the **Wilco Parks Department** and the **Williamson County Conservation Foundation (WCCF)** have included trail projects at Twin Springs Preserve, a trail usage survey along the Brushy Creek Regional Trail and the ongoing coordination and presentation of **Leave No Trace** classes.*
