Volunteers are required to meet the eligibility criteria:

1. Live in West Oakland, in the area bordered by Interstate 880, Beach Street, Shellmound Street/40th Street, Horton Street, Yerba Buena Avenue, Hollis Street, Interstate 580, Interstate 980, Castro Street, 2nd Street, property boundaries, Magnolia Street, and 3rd Street.
2. Be a business owner/general manager of a business or non-profit entity in West Oakland, or
3. Be the designee of a business owner/general manager of a business or non-profit entity in West Oakland.

The Responsibilities of Advisory Council members:

- Make a one year commitment to attend one meeting per month, planned for the third Monday of the month from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm.
- Contribute your expertise, make recommendations, serve as a sounding board and bring a fresh perspective to the development project.
- Allow WOBS to publish your name as a member of the Council.

In return, the WOBS Development Team promises:

- Meetings that start and end on time
- An appreciation of your time and a commitment not to abuse your time or your generosity
- A meaningful and rewarding experience
