APPLICATION PROCEDURE



TIHTC encourages applicants to apply as early as possible and make sure all documentation is in order before submission. Applications for Emergency Care and Burn Injuries Management project training should be submitted before Aug 22nd, 2025.

Supporting documents preparation

• CV, passport copy, medical reports (Chest X-ray, Hepatitis B, syphilis, measles, rubella, etc.), ID photo, recommendation letter, diploma, English certificate, etc.

Fill out the online application form and upload supporting documents

In case of missing documents, the applicant is required to submit them within 2
weeks of receiving notice, otherwise the application will be considered invalid and
may be rejected.

3 Application review

• Application reviews are conducted jointly by TIHTC and the Ministry of Health and Welfare. Other supplementary documents may be requested if needed.

4 Acceptance

Upon receiving the final decision from the MOHW, TIHTC will notify applicants via email.

5 Visa application
