5. What would have to happen where you would PRAY with a heart of gratitude every day without complaining?
6. Read Romans 15:13. Has God filled you with His Hope? Do you trust God in all aspects of your life? Why or why not? (Be honest.)
7. What would it take for you to focus on what God has done, now what you think He hasn't done?
8. What are your needs today? Not your wants! Take a minute to list them. Pray about them.
9. Have you fully submitted to God in all areas of your life? Especially when it comes to your needs? Can you pray this, "*Heavenly Father, may Your will be done on earth (through me) as it is in Heaven, may I trust You today for every need in my life?*"
10. What would it take for you to fully TRUST IN GOD for everything?
