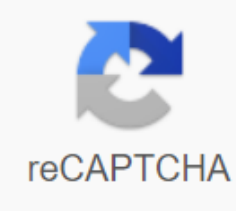

Concerts poetic beauty (Northern Echo) About this piece In his early years, Albeniz was an adventurer who studied in France and Belgium, became a student of Liszt in Germany, escaped to Puerto Rico and Cuba, crossed the United States on a concert tour that took him to San Francisco, and worked as a bar-room entertainer on the New York waterfront. He made a fortune and lost them as a pianist, became a successful operetta composer for the London Theatre, and finally settled in Paris to live and work as a serious musician. Like many Spanish composers, he was born in Catalonia, in the northeastern region of the Iberian Peninsula. But he soon fell under the spell and the popular music of Andalusia in the south, and its success in adapting its colorful idiom to concert music soon defined him as typically Spanish to the rest of the music world. The sound of the guitar is heard everywhere in Albeniz's work, and these two piano pieces were transcribed by John Williams. These are works inspired by two beautiful Spanish places, the fertile Mediterranean island of Mallorca and the great city and province of Cordoba, which was the Iberian center of Muslim and Jewish culture.
