

Maryland Justice Passport

Preliminary Technology Requirements

Functional Requirements

- Accessible on any device (mobile-friendly but not a mobile application)
- The litigant can take pictures of documents with their phone and add them to their passport
- The litigant can upload photos/documents from computer or device files
- The passport will be available in a paper format and mimic the online tool as much as possible
- Legal services organizations can access the litigant's documents and case information upon the litigant's explicit permission
- The Passport will guide the litigant through the process of finding legal assistance
- The Passport will show the litigant which organizations they have requested help from and the status of their request
- The Passport will allow self-help centers and legal services organizations to add information and to-do items to a Litigant's Passport
- The Passport will have English and Spanish languages available

Security/Privacy Requirements

- The litigant will be required to create a profile with a username and password
- Legal services organizations will be required to create a profile with a username and password
- The user can choose which organization(s) to share their documents and case information with
- Legal services organizations cannot see the notes that other legal services organizations write about their acceptance or rejection of the case
