Brief description of the project * The Project will educate and upskill recent migrants from non-English speaking backgrounds residing in Northern Beaches to conduct or "establish a business using their own language and cultural skills" (James Griffin)

Demonstrate how the project will address Multicultural NSW Strategic priorities of Community, Language and Capability *

COMMUNITY

The project will enable its participants to identify and nourish sustainable relationships that can help the young people or their start-ups to conduct wide-reaching business locally and internationally. This will include collaboration with established firms from various sectors. It will prepare the young culturally diverse entrepreneurs to create new robust relationships and will teach them how to effectively access existing networks by offering and sharing their unique skills and knowledge.

LANGUAGE

The project will include young people aged 16-25 from non-English speaking backgrounds. Apart from referring its participants, where necessary, to specialised programmes to improve English language skills, the Project will create international trade opportunities, where participation through language and application of specific cultural knowledge of the participating young people

will be encouraged in order to generate tangible lasting outcomes.

CAPABILITY

The project will build the capability of Northern Beaches to conduct business locally and internationally. It will utilise cultural diversity to facilitate business and trade outcomes. Aiming for common good through business by young people from diverse backgrounds will generate enough positive social momentum to improve social cohesion and community harmony in the Northern Beaches society.

Common incubator-like space for the local diverse start-ups, supporting the focus on local priority sectors (young people, tourism and transport) expert training, opening the existing networks and creating new business relationships will inevitably enhance communication, coordination and capability across private sector, local communities, and government in Northern Beaches.

Demonstrate how the project will measure outcomes. Please provide details of measurement tools, analysis and ongoing monitoring. *

The program has a defined process that enables measurement of progress for everyone in the program. The progress is measured objectively by experienced and independent local entrepreneurs and mentors.

Across the initial 6 days of workshops, the attendees progress each day through 6 stages and each day they refine their pitch, both in terms of content and delivery.

At the conclusion of each of the first 5 days, the delegates are given a scorecard detailing what they need to focus on the for next day and what homework they should do that evening.

The sixth day incorporates a formal pitch contest with independent judges who will agree the best three pitches. The proposal is that prizes are awarded (based on securing a sponsor) to the best 3 pitches being \$3,000 for 1st, \$2,000 for second and \$1,000 for 3rd.

We invite Multicultural NSW to provide up to 2 judges for the final pitch night.

The teams participating in the Diversity Project will provide clear measures of success by virtue of their readiness to launch a business during the 12 month duration of the Project.

What research did your organisation undertake to develop the project and how did it prove that there was a real need? *

Research of Australian Bureau of Statistics, Census of Population and Housing 2016 identified that the migrant population of Northern Beaches (those that arrived in Australia within 5 years prior to 2016) was 13,580.

Research of statistics of, and consultations with the Northern Beaches Council confirmed that migrants have difficulties settling into and contributing to Australian society (also see <https://profile.id.com.au/northern-beaches/arrivals-introduction>).

Ongoing consultations with local social services and further research into local employment, community behaviour and community ties. This confirms that recently arrived migrants, often lack locally applicable skills in creating productive relationships and face barriers when trying to contribute to the local innovation industry or to actively pursue business aims. These people need support to overcome social barriers, acquire the relevant business skills and utilise cross-cultural engagement.

The NSW State Member for Manly James Griffin MP confirmed that: "Manly has a thriving technology and innovation industry. The SEVENmile Venture Lab will assist in strengthening the opportunity for startups and high growth ventures to consider Manly as a destination, and for those who are already here, it will accelerate growth. Ultimately, this is good for local employers and our young people wanting jobs for the 21st century. I stand ready to support the SEVENmile Venture Lab and congratulate Greg and the management team."
