




Seppelt (SA Brewing) bought over Penfolds & Lindemans





THE DRIVE

In 1865 the gold rush in Victoria began. Local gold miners to tunnel the underground cellars that became known as The Drives.









Seppelt The Drives Chardonnay

Producer: Seppelt

Grape: Shiraz

Region: Victorian, Australia

About the Wine:

Sourced from a cool region provides a fresh and vibrant Chardonnay. Oaked in small and large French oak for richness (70%) and stainless steel at 30% to maintain bright aromatics. 9 months lees for a textured palate.

Aroma & Flavour

The nose displays aromas of white peach, and melon combined with oatmeal and sweet toasty oak.



Seppelt The Drive Shiraz

Producer: Seppelt

Grape: Shiraz

Region: Victorian, Australia

About the Wine:

Aged in 20% new French oak and 80% seasoned French oak for one year.

Aroma & Flavour

The nose displays aromas of bright red fruits, violets and spice combined with berry compote and a hint of pepper.

















Seppelt NV Original Sparkling Shiraz

Producer: Seppelt

Grape: Shiraz

Region: Victorian, Australia

About the Wine:

Vinified on skins in a combination of static and open-top fermenters followed by maturation in 70% stainless steel and 30% seasoned French oak for 12 months prior to secondary fermentation

Aroma & Flavour

Aromas of mulberry and blue fruits with exotic spices and a lifted floral nose.











Seppelt NV Fleur de Lys Sparkling

Producer: Seppelt

Grape: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir **Region:** Victorian, Australia

About the Wine:

The wine was matured on its lees to increase texture and complexity.

Aroma & Flavour

The nose is fresh with strawberry fruit, a touch of creamy yeast and grassiness.









Seppelt Foundation Jaluka Chardonnay

Seppelt Foundation Range and deriving its name from the picturesque Jaluka Forest in the Northern Grampians of Western Victoria, Seppelt Jaluka Chardonnay is expressive of the cool maritime climate of the Henty region.



About the Wine:

Whole bunch pressed, barrel fermented with solids included and no MLF. Lees stirred once a month and matured for 9 months in a combination of French oak barriques (18% new oak)

Aroma & Palate


Aromas of white flowers, roasted nuts and grapefruit pith complemented by flinty barrel ferment characters.



Seppelt Chalamber Shiraz

First crafted in 1953 by Australian winemaking legend Colin Preece, Chalambar is a highly sought-after Shiraz of excellent pedigree. Named after the picturesque Mount Chalambar located in Victoria's Grampians region.









Seppelt Chalamber Shiraz

About the Wine:

Premium parcels of Shiraz from the Grampians and Heathcote were fermented on skins for an average of 8 days, then matured in a combination of 225 L French oak barriques (80%) and 3000 L seasoned French oak vats (20%) for 12 months. Overall 15% new French oak.

Aroma & Palate

Fragrant raspberry fruit, violets and savoury spice with a hint of liquorice.













Seppelt Mount Ida Shiraz

About the Wine:

Aged in 40% new French oak and 60% seasoned French oak for one year.

Aroma & Flavour

The nose displays aromas of dark plums and chocolate with earthy spice and meaty elements in the background.
