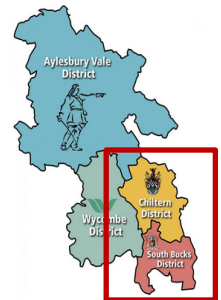


Local Plan Update

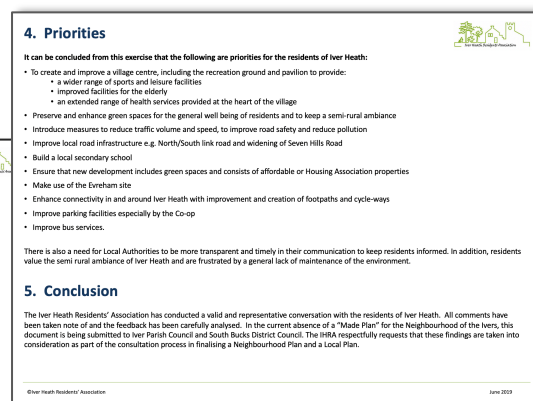
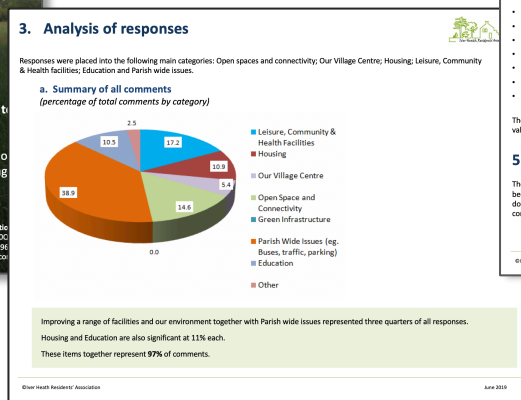
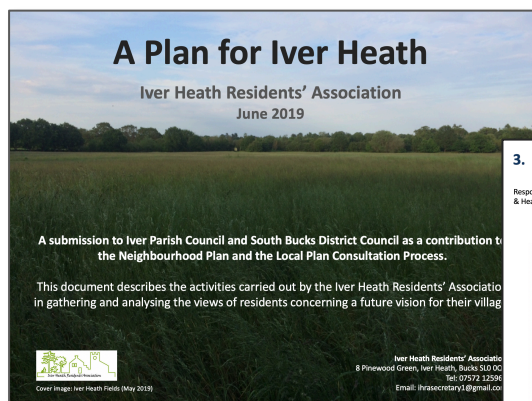

IHRA: A Plan for Iver Heath



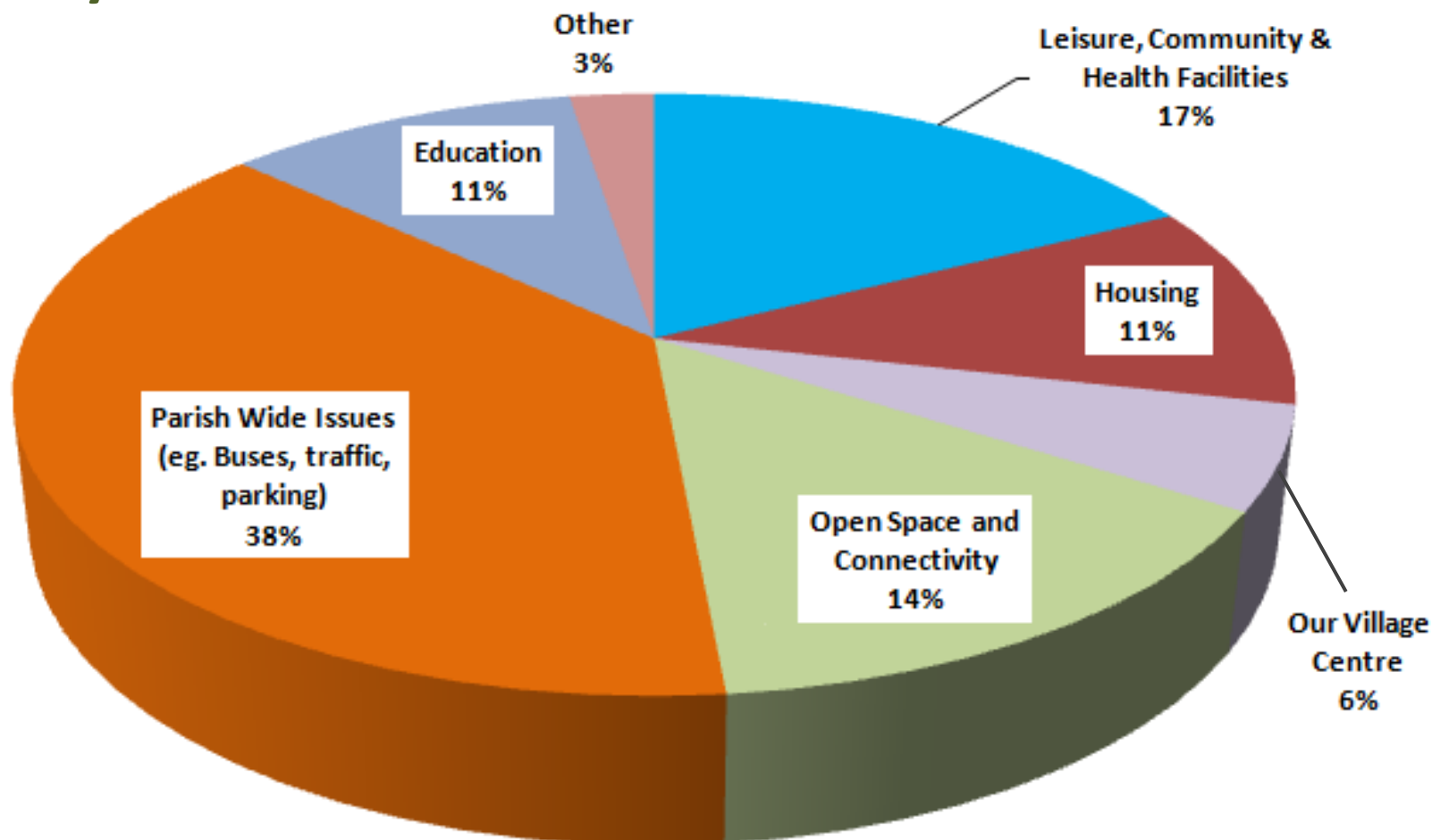
- Committee members attended **three IPC consultation meetings**

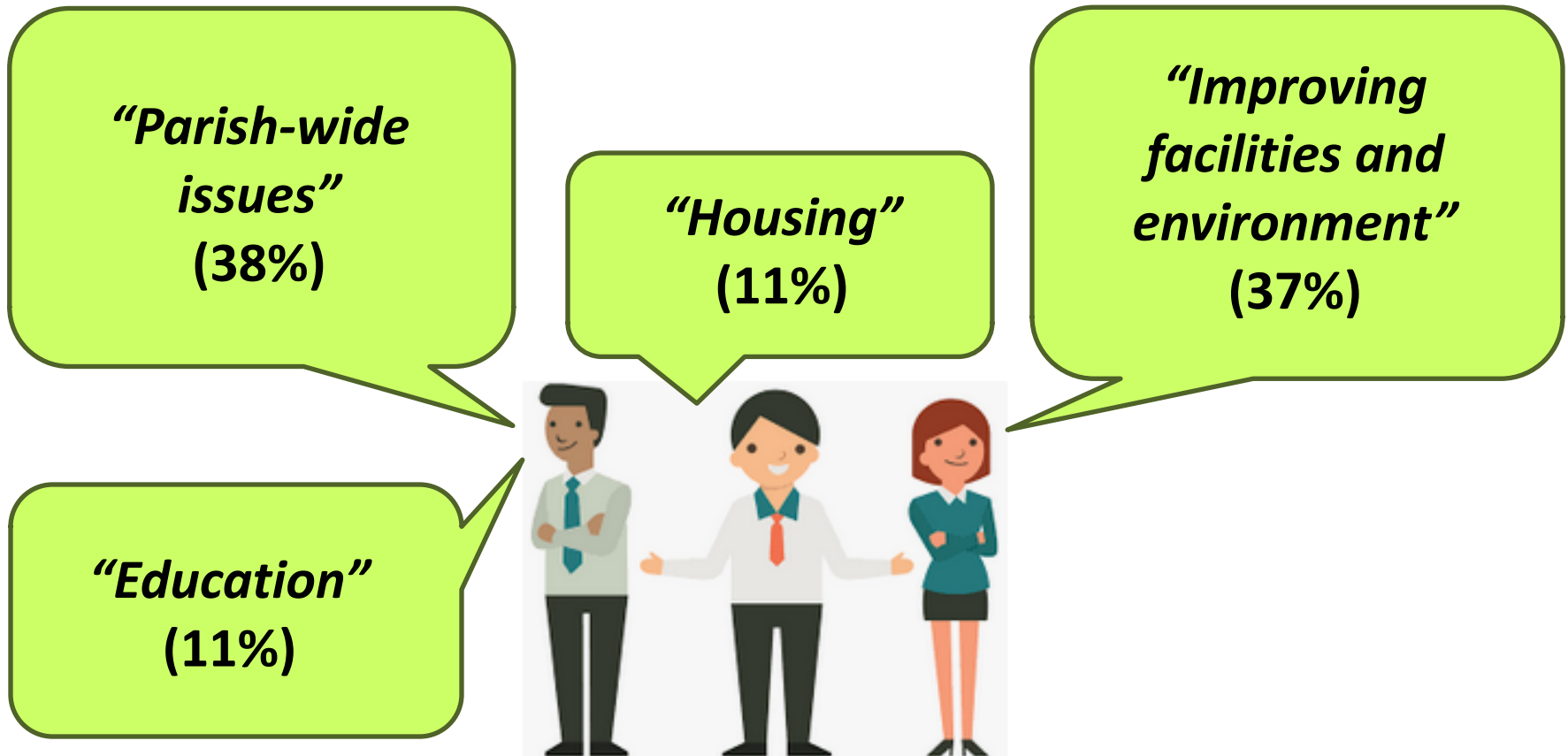
