Florida has just added 1.4 million potential voters to its lists by adopting Amendment 4, which has restored people with past convictions for criminal rights. While the state's voters did so, they had little encouragement from John Oliver, who devoted a segment last week to the issue as early as September. The idea of giving voting rights to violent criminals, such as murderers and sex offenders, is not a particularly sane idea, but Oliver notes that only 18% of criminals fall into this category -- and the Florida Amendment doesn't apply to them either way. For years, the vast majority of convicted offences were nonviolent offenders who had served their sentences but were still unable to vote. While many states make it harder for perpetrators to regain their voting rights, according to Oliver, the worst situation of all is Florida. His strict, complex demands led to a system that made one in five African-Americans hanged, which is why Oliver called the state so publicly. Voters apparently listened, with Amendment 4, and again condemned 1.4 million potential voters. According to a nonprofit group, a public citizen, this is not only the repeal of one of the state's worst Jim Crow laws, it's also the largest expansion in voting rights since the Voting Rights Act. Well done, Florida! And well done, John Oliver. To learn more about this issue, check out last week's segment on crime disenfranchisement. In Florida, you can use your will to appoint a personal representative to ensure that the provisions in your ohio are implemented after your death. In any case, you will need to finalize your changes with the same formalities that you used for your original will (see above). If you and your spouse divorce (or if the court finds that your marriage is not legal), Florida law revokes any language in your resurrect, which leaves the property to your spouse or appoints your spouse as your personal representative. Playwright Lucas Hnath is not one of the usual theatricals. His play Isaac's Eye (seen here in the Writers Theatre) is part of a historical lecture, part full-cloth fiction about Isaac Newton. Hillary and Clinton, who premiered at Victory Gardens, seek an alternate version of the presidential candidate during the 2008 race. Hnath's upcoming Broadway debut is an unauthorized Ibson sequence titled A Doll's House, Part 2. Christians who received a careful Chicago premiere in Steppenwolf are no exception. The 80-minute play is in the form of a service to an evangelical megahurch, complete with commoful music (it pays to arrive early for the choir's pre-heating) and the central sermons of the church leader, the pastor Pavla (the very direct Tom Irwin, who promotes cadence and the character of contemporary preaching). Paul's

presents his congregation with theological zagato: The priest has ceased to believe in the literal Hell, and unilaterally proclaims this church, which he founded, no longer believes in Hell, nor does he. But Paul decided not to consult anyone else before this proclamation from the primney, and not everyone who hears is ready for such radical change. Modern American culture, whether theatre, film, television or literature, sometimes treats characters and worries like these, with low appreciating, or betrays a clear sense of which side the author believes is right. Not so here; Each character, including a non-conti united pastor (Glenn Davis), the head of the board of the elderly (Robert Breuler), the pastor's wife (Shannon Cochran) and the conflicting parish (the wonderful Jacqueline Williams)– is depicted with fluctuations and compassion, and the philosophical discord that develops between them is treated with serious reflection. It's not hard to see parallels with more secular types of congregations, actually – say institutional kina. Listen to the long-time member of the Irwin ensemble, who is in terms of the church's growth from warehouse to refuge, with all the competing interests and fiduciary concerns that are in this part, and you can imagine Christians as an accessory to the steppenwolf himself. Hnath's use of believers can turn off some congregations – if the church has itchy in real life, K. Todd Freeman's faithful music can provoke a similar reaction.
