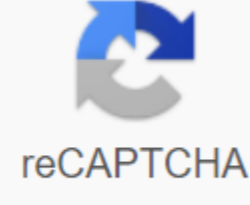

COVID-19 Updates Sign Up Deeds Office: Acquire Vital Records: To continue accepting the idea of social detachment of the 2nd and 3-storey administration building is closed to the public unless the appointment has been made. These appointments are for urgent business only. If you need a birth, marriage or death certificate, print the appropriate form, fill it in and add appropriate taxes. Mail (USPS) to our office, or drop it into a drop box at the administrative office curb, located at 508 New York Avenue, Sheboygan, WI 53081. Another option is to order [www.vitalchek.com](http://www.vitalchek.com) (NOTE: you don't need to use ups for delivery, just check the usual USPS mail back option). Rest assured that your application will be processed in a timely manner. Our office aims to process and return your application within 24 hours. Remember that our office can issue birth and marriage records from any county in Wisconsin. For emergency service we have application forms near the elevator on the ground floor of our building. Follow the instructions below. Mission Must be financially responsible while serving the public politely and amicably, as well as fulfilling the state statutes that dictate our office along with preserving and protecting real estate records, vital records and various documents. Summary of responsibility The Document Office Register is the main source of legal documents that affects almost every person living in Sheboygan County. This includes personal and real estate ownership and clampdown records, in addition to financial instruments that are the basis for individual and business credit ratings. This office carries out the final admission and filing of new departments of plats and certified survey maps, administered by the Vital Records registration system, which includes registration of all births, marriages and deaths of county residents, probate instruments, and business documents such as corporate filings. Other responsibilities include recording, preparing and issuing copies of military documents, alternative informal probate procedures (TDI-110) and registering federal tax liens by the U.S. Treasury. Other statutory duties include collecting taxes and fees, and these taxes are split between Sheboygan County and Wisconsin states. The required reports shall be Government agencies: U.S. Treasury (Federal IRS Tax Liens), Wisconsin Revenue Department (transfer tax collection and property valuation tax equalization), Wisconsin Administration Department (plat review and Wisconsin Land Information Program) and Wisconsin Department of Health and Social Services (Vital Records) Sheboygan County offices that depend on our information and services include the County Veterans Services Office, Planning, Secretary of Courts, County Treasurer/Real Estate and county department. Recorded land records are the basis of property tax. Unapproved copies are public records. Records from October 1907 to now can be ordered for \$20 by post, by fax, or in person from the Wisconsin Department of Health Vital Records Office in Madison and online via VitalChek. Until 1907, historical records date back to almost 1846 counties: 1848 (marriage), 1852 (births) and 1854 (death). These entries are incomplete and available from the Wisconsin Historical Society, with a statewide index online. Sheboygan is known for its large German population historically.
