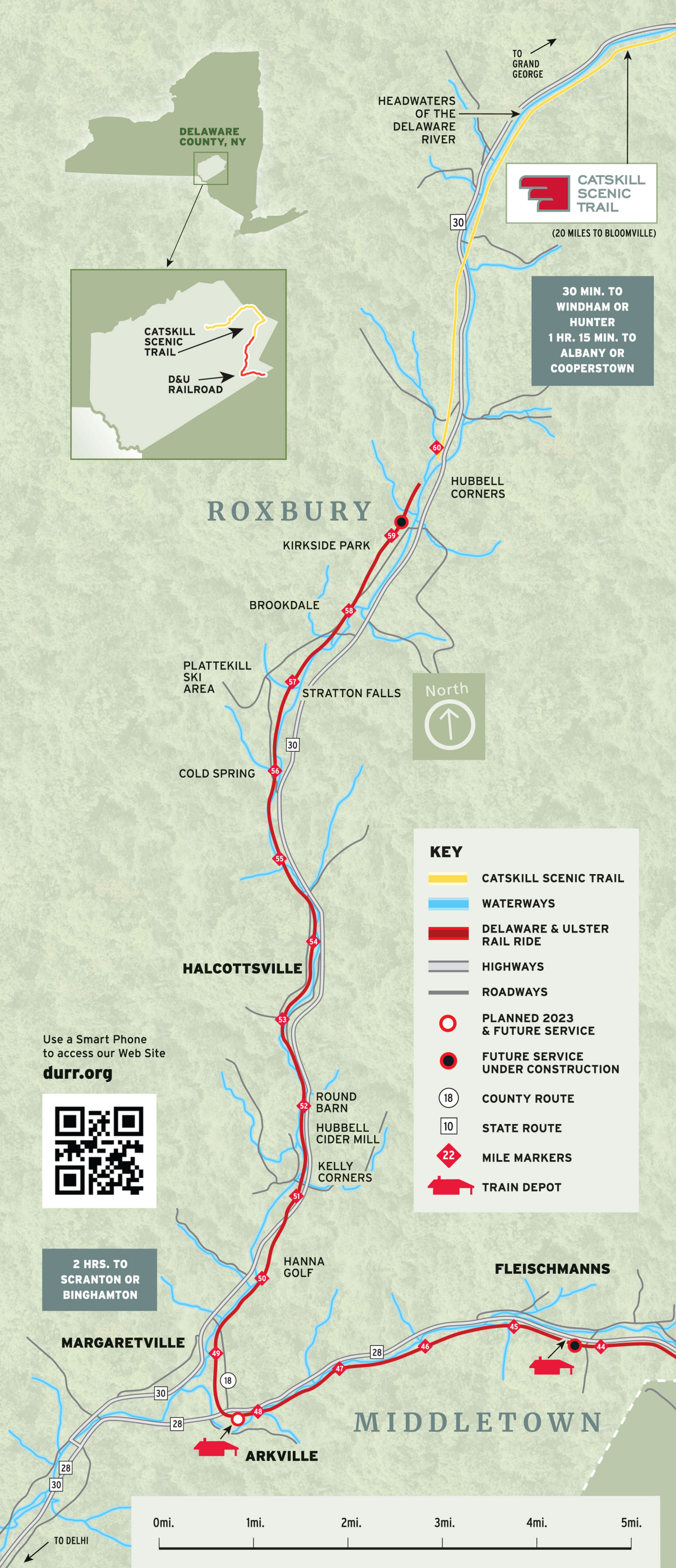




TRAIN RIDE

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THE ORIGINAL ULSTER AND DELAWARE RAILROAD COMPANY (U&D)

was a Class I railroad headquartered in Rondout (part of present-day Kingston) and founded in 1866. It was often advertised as "The Only All-Rail Route to the Catskill Mountains." At its greatest extent, the U&D ran from Kingston Point on the Hudson River through the heart of the Catskills to Oneonta.

After the inevitable demise of the original passenger operation in the 1950s and the end of the remaining freight service in the 1970s, the operation was reborn in the 1980s as the scenic Delaware & Ulster Railroad. For three decades riders enjoyed breathtaking views while riding the rails on various vintage trains, until the great pandemic of 2020 once again halted service.

2023 marks the start of yet another new chapter for the Delaware & Ulster. The trains are returning to operation starting with the dining train, under new management and rebranded the Silver Rose for the next leg of its journey.

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
