INDEX OF ASSIGNED SERIAL NUMBERS	
<p>On this page are shown the assigned serial numbers for the production of .30 Carbine from 1942 through 1945. In many instances you will undoubtedly encounter carbines that do not match this listing. This was usually caused by the prime contractor using up their assigned numbers and continuing to produce carbines until a new serial number block was assigned. Other rare carbines will also be found. These include as the late WRA production which used Underwood receivers with serial numbers from Underwood's assigned serial number block.</p> <p>The dates reflect estimated periods within which the serial numbers were probably used. There are definite periods of transition from one serial number block to the next wherein this chart may not be accurate. Considerable latitude should be given when using the dates to determine the actual configuration of a carbine. It should be noted that if a receiver was scrapped during assembly or proof firing, that receiver's serial number was reassigned and used at a later date. This list was compiled from examination of carbines appearing to be original. Factory documentation of sell dates by serial number is almost nonexistent. It is probable that in several areas my research was flawed by evaluation of carbines that were manufactured out of serial number sequence.</p>
