## Broward county marriage license

Marriage certificates can only be issued for marriages taking place in Florida from June 6, 1927 to the present. Marriage certificates until June 6, 1927 can be obtained from the secretary of the county court, where the marriage license was issued. Brenda D. Please remember that the information provided through this site is not the Secretary's official court records. It is my continued commitment to continue to improve this site and the services offered both here and in my office. When applying for a marriage license, both parties, aged 18 and over, must be present. The Florida marriage license allows the couple to marry anywhere in Florida, regardless of the county license was purchased. If you are getting married outside of Florida, get a marriage license from the state where you will be married. Florida residents have the option to attend a premarital course from a registered provider, or wait for a 3-day mandatory period of time before a marriage license takes effect. The Online Prenuptial Rate Supplier Directory is available to assist you in finding a premarital supplier course (see clerk for certificate requirements), or you will find a copy of this registry anywhere in the marriage service (is in the column on the right). Non-Florida residents are exempt from any waiting period for a marriage license. Marriage license identification requirements: a valid photo ID of the federal or state government is required, which must provide the correct legal name, date of birth and signature of the applicant. The types of photo ID accepted are: U.S. Driver's License (U.S. or Government) U.S. Passport Military ID (U.S. or Government) Alien Registration Card Under the Florida State Charter, any person who has been issued a Social Security number must provide their Social Security number during the marriage license application process. Copies of a Social Security card are not needed, only the number of the Social Security card. Any person who is not a U.S. citizen can provide a Social Security number or foreign registration number if it has been issued. If none of them has been issued, a different form of identity may be required. Other useful information: Blood tests are not required. You don't need to be a resident of this county or state of Florida to get a license to Marriage licenses are used in Florida for sixty (60) days Date. The Family Law Handbook in English or Spanish must be read before obtaining a marriage license. The Family Law Handbook is also available for review in the Marriage And One Foot Divisions. If any of the applicants had previously been married, the exact date of the last divorce, death or annulment should be given. To speed up the application process, please complete our online advance application, print it out and take it with you to one of the Broward County offices (located in the column on the right) to complete the application process. Requirements for an ageless marriage license of at least 17 years of age: In addition to the above requirements, the following documents must be submitted when one or both applicants are within that age: Any applicant under the age of eighteen (18) and at least seventeen (17) years must have the consent of both parents or legal guardian. If custody of such a minor has been granted to one of the parents, the original evidence must be provided. You can get consent forms in this office. If one of the parents has died, a certified copy of the death certificate is required. The age and identity of the parents must be confirmed. This can be done with a certified copy of a person's birth certificate. If the parents' names do not match, additional proof may be required. In addition, a person at least 17 years of age may marry only if the other party is no older than two years old. Applicants under the age of 17: Per F.S. 741.04, we are prohibited from issuing a license to anyone under the age of 17. Marriage License Review To obtain a marriage license in Broward County, you both must: Bring a valid photo ID (driver's license/state ID, passport, military ID, or someone else's registration card) Know your Social Security number, however, the card itself is not necessary To read the Family Law Handbook (included in our premarital course for your convenience) Payment of marriage license fees. However, couples who attend an approved prenuptial course are exempt from the waiting period and will have a reduced marriage license fee of \$61.00. In order to receive this discount, the couple must provide a certificate of completion of the county clerk at the time of their application. Using Marriage License - Restrictions When a couple receives their marriage license, it will be valid for 60 days from the date of issuance. Remember that there is a 3-day waiting period for any Florida resident (unless they complete the premarital course). The marriage license must be returned to the clerk's office within 10 days of the ceremony. Couples who choose to attend a civil marriage ceremony can do so in the Marriage Division if they choose an additional fee if the license is valid. Ask a question, get the answer answered To fill out an application for a marriage license, the couple must: Both applicants must be at least 18 years old to apply without parental consent. If one of the applicants is under the age of 18 but at least 16 years old, a birth certificate and identity card are required, as well as a notary form of written consent of the parents or guardian. Applicants under the age of 16 must obtain a determination from a district court judge. No blood test required. A \$93.50 fee is required at the time of application for a marriage license. When applying for a marriage license, when a valid certificate of completion of the pre-nuptial course is issued by a registered premarital provider, the application fee must be reduced from \$93.50 to \$61.00. A printed copy of the certificate of completion of the pre-nuptial course must be submitted to the District Court Secretary to apply for a reduction in the application fee. Both applicants must also read the Family Law Handbook. This is required by law. Be sure to contact your local Broward County Clerk's Office well before the wedding to find out what days and during what hours the clerk will be in the office. Some locations may require an appointment. Marriage ID Requirement Florida: ✓ get a copy of the Photo Identification Birth Certificate (e.g. driver's license, state ID, or valid passport or I-94 card.) Both parties will also have to provide their Social Security numbers but do not need to provide their Social Security cards. You may be asked for a certified copy of your birth certificate. Florida residents have a three-day waiting period if they meet the following criteria: If both parties are residents of Florida and have participated in a 4 hour pre-nuptial course, they do not have a three-day waiting period. Each applicant must provide proof, of course, completion when applying for a marriage license. The course provider must list the hours completed for counselling and the letter must be submitted on the company/church form. All service providers of the area course must be registered with the District Court Clerk under Florida Charter 741.0305 (5). If both parties are not residents of Florida, you do not need to provide proof of premarital counseling. As non-Florida residents, you don't have a waiting period. However, all couples who apply for a marriage license should read the Family Law Handbook. In addition, both residents and non-Florida residents can get a \$32.50 discount on a marriage license by completing a premarital course. The course must be completed no more than a year before the date of application for a marriage license. Both sides must attend the course, and, once again, the certificate of completion be submitted at the time of application to be eligible for a discount. Previous marriages: ✓ Finding Marriage If you were previously married, the date of your divorce or the date of your spouse's death should be granted. If the divorce or death of the spouse occurred within the last 30 days, a certified copy of the divorce decree or death certificate is required. No. No blood tests are required. The standard marriage license fee is \$93.50. The reduced fee for applicants (Florida residents only) who have completed a attendance course is \$61.00. Cash is the preferred payment method. For recommendations on additional payment methods, please call in advance. Pre-marriage preparation in Florida: As of January 1, 1999, Florida residents who prepare for marriage offered by an approved service provider may receive certain privileges. If both couples are Florida residents, you will receive a \$32.50 discount on the marriage license fee. In addition, the three-day waiting period will be cancelled. Both partners must prove that they have taken the course in the last twelve months. The certificate of completion of the approved marriage preparation course given by a qualified instructor will be accepted as evidence. In addition, a letter will be accepted from a representative of a religious institution recognized under the Florida Statute. This letter must be on the official clerical affiliations of the cleric. Non-Florida residents are not eligible for a lower fee for taking an approved marriage preparation course. They have to pay the entire fee \$93.50. However, if they took the accepted course of preparation for marriage, the three-day waiting period would be abolished. It is important that you check all the information with your local Broward County Clerk's Office before making the trip to buy a marriage license. Proxy Marriages Florida: No. Cousin Marriages Florida: Yes. First and second cousins can legally marry in Florida. Common Florida Marriages: No. The legal age of marriage without parental consent is eighteen (18 years). The legal age of marriage with parental consent is sixteen years (16 years). A marriage application may not be issued for those under the age of sixteen if the bride has a doctor's certificate that she is pregnant. At this time, the bride and groom will sign an affidavit stating that they are the parents of the expected child, and the parent (s) will sign the consent (s) for the marriage. If the bride has a doctor's certificate of pregnancy, regardless of whether the parents agree to the marriage, the hearing will be held before the district judge with appropriate notification to the parents (s). A minor who was previously married can also apply for a license. Name change: Getting a license marriage with your new name on it doesn't mean your name has automatically changed. If you need to change your surname, you can use online set of marriage name changes. Marriage Officiants Florida: Any ordained or licensed clergy, notaries and judges of the world. Witnesses are not required in Florida. Florida Marriage License validity: Marriage license valid for 60 days after issuance. You must hold the wedding ceremony before the expiration of this 60 days.
