Lily Mai has been in attendance 113 days and absent for 29. She is frequently late for school. She is well presented with her tidy hair and clean face and hands. There may be ongoing headlice but Sheree is making every effort to sort that out.

Lily is kind caring and helpful child. She is not as confident with the other children in her class as she was earlier in the year. She is very dependent on her cousin and can be timid and hang back from the others.

We are very concerned about Lily's progress in school. She has poor writing skills and gives up very easily. She has no confidence in her own ability and is becoming aware of the gap between what she can do and what the others in her class can do. Lily Mai's homework is rarely
