Health & Safety

At a recent visit, the guards said *the school should be doing more to ensure the safety of the children*. We need **your co-operation** to do the right thing and park safely on the Bawnmore, not in the school grounds. I have discussed this matter with the Parents Association and we will have to take further measures if parents continue to ignore this safety message.
