SELF CONTAINED RVs

The Common - Common Rd, Dungog: Walking distance, west of Dungog town centre, The Common is 680 acres of flat land to rolling hills. Fully self-contained vehicles can rest for a maximum of 4 nights. There is no fee however Dungog Common Recreation Reserve Trust volunteers appreciate donations to help maintain and upgrade this lovely area.

The Common is perfect for mountain biking, horse riding and bush walking. No fires are allowed and you can walk well behaved dogs but they must be under control or on a leash. Dungog's Dump Point is at the Dungog Showground.

Getting Here

FLY

Dungog is fifty minutes from Newcastle Airport at Williamtown. Destinations you can fly to from Newcastle Airport are: Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, the Gold Coast, Ballina/Byron, Canberra, Dubbo and Taree.

TRAIN

- Three and a half hours from Sydney Central by XPT
- Four and a half from Sydney Central by Transport NSW, changing at Hamilton for Dungog.

We have been assured by NSW TrainLink there will be no track work over the Festival weekend so jump on a train and leave the car at home. Most venues are within walking distance of the train station and there is a shuttle bus or train can deliver you to some outlying events.

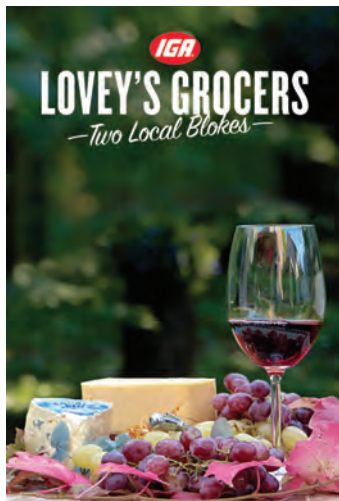

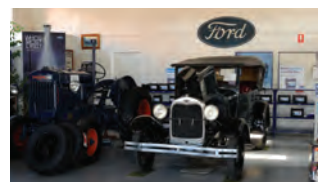
