97% of all European buildings need to be upgraded and the renovation rate must increase from 1% to 3 %. The 2030 energy and climate goals set by the European Union cannot be achieved without mobilising significant private investment in homes and commercial buildings.



Building renovation is about people. We spend 90% of our time indoors, thus buildings impact our health, well-being and work productivity Today, 1 in 6 Europeans lives in unhealthy homes. Those effected by energy poverty are 3 times as likely to live in damp and unhealthy buildings which can result in a 40% higher chance of developing asthma.

Building renovation can be stressful, expensive and difficult. EuroPACE was designed to make it easy, fast and reliable for all Europeans.

This is an opportunity to meet the EU goals and improve comfort and health of European citizens. Financing is part of the solution.





Innovating Building Renovation for Europe

EuroPACE is inspired by the success of a financing model called PACE, developed in the US. PACE financing covers up to 100% of a project's costs and is repaid as a special charge added to a property tax bill over a term of up to 20 years. Homeowners enjoy lower energy bills and simple & fast approval process. EuroPACE adopts best practices from the US PACE market and intends to further enhance its reach, scope, and overall impact well beyond the American experience.

Unique financing attributes of PACE coupled with people-centric market deployment is the reason for its success. PACE programs funded over \$5 billion worth of energy efficiency, renewable energy and water conservation projects, resulting in more than 40,000 new local jobs and the creation of hundreds new companies. It is time for EuroPACE.

Empowering Cities to Lead the Way

Home and commercial building renovation is not just a private business, but a public priority. Thus, cities can take an active role to enable private capital to help accelerate building renovation. At its core EuroPACE is a public-private partnership.

The city of Olot, Spain is currently developing an EuroPACE pilot focusing on residential buildings. Several European cities, including Bilbao, Frankfurt, Kassel, Ladornac, Lisbon, Macerata, Pisa, Porto, Prague, and Toledo, have already expressed their interest in EuroPACE. About EuroPACE Project and Partners

- **2. Deploy EuroPACE in Spain:** Design and run the first residential EuroPACE pilot in the city of Olot (Catalunya, Spain).
- **3. Scale Across Europe:** Facilitate and support 4 Leader Cities willing to set up EuroPACE program for building renovation.

The project consortium consists of 8 partners from 4 European countries: Spain, Italy, Poland and the UK.





















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
