Chapter VII of the UN Charter is governed by acts dealing with threats to peace, violations of peace and acts of aggression. there are several main chapters in this chapter: Articles 39, 40, 41, 42 and 51. Before we discuss these articles, we must look at Chapter I, Article 2(4), which states that all members in their international relations refrain from threatening acts or violence against the territorial integrity or political independence of another country or in any way against the purposes of the United Nations. The use of force is understood as a military attack, an armed attack: by an organized military, a navy or an air force of a country; but this concept in practice and in principle has an even greater significance. this is happening in Palestine because of Israeli military aggression in the Gaza Strip by destroying what it considers Hamas headquarters..... According to international law expert Professor Hikmahanto Juwana, speaking in a discussion on the conflict in Gaza in the light of international law, Israel's attack on the Gaza Strip had violated the UN Charter. Although the Jewish state claims its attacks as self-defense, it still violates the UN Charter. Israel should inform the UN DK, which will succeed it in accordance with Article 51 of the UN Charter. No provision of this Charter shall infringe the right of individuals or jointly to defend themselves in the event of an armed attack on an individual member of the United Nations until the Security Council takes the necessary measures to safeguard international peace and security. The measures taken by members in the exercise of this right of self-defence must be

reported immediately to the Kearnanan Council, and in no way must the powers and responsibilities of the Security Council under this Charter be compromised to take at any time what is deemed necessary to maintain or restore international peace and security (Article 51) in this context, Israel has, of course, disregarded the UN Charter for the invasion of the Gaza Strip without the permission of the UNITED Nations. , leading to a decline in Palestinian civilian Led. But it is a common secret. Secret. Without the blessing of the UN DK, but there is already an agreement with the US, then anything can happen to destroy Palestine in Jaluur Gaza, under the pretext of self-defense. The other articles of Chapter VII of the UN Charter also stipulate that the Security Council shall decide whether there is a threat to peace, a violation of peace or an act of aggression, and will advocate or decide what measures to take in accordance with Articles 41 and 42 to maintain or restore international peace and security. In order to prevent a deterioration of circumstances, the Security Council may, before issuing a report or decision on measures within the meaning of Article 39, request the parties concerned to accept temporary measures deemed necessary or appropriate. In the meantime, the measures will be implemented in violation of the rights of the claim or the position of the parties concerned. The Security Council shall take care to resist the implementation of such temporary measures. The Security Council may decide what measures go beyond the deployment of armed forces in order to take decisions and invite the members of the United Nations to implement those measures. This includes the termination of all or part of economic relations, including railways, seas, air, postal services, telegraph, radio and other communication tools, as well as diplomatic relations. If the Security Council considers that the measures referred to in Article 41 are considered insufficient or insufficient, the Council may take measures by deploying air, sea or land forces that may be necessary to maintain or restore internal peace and security. These include demonstrations, blockades and other actions involving the air, sea or land forces of members of the United Nations. Given Israel's stance against the aggression in Gaza, the UN-DK certainly did not act at the time of inaction until the UN DK was convened twice, but no official statement was made on Israel's military aggression against the Gaza Strip.
