ITINERARY

SEPTEMBER 11 | ALBERTA TO REGINA, SK

And we're off! After boarding our deluxe motor coach the tour to Eastern Canada begins!

SEPTEMBER 12 | WINNIPEG, MB

An evening in Manitoba's capital.

SEPTEMBER 13 | THUNDER BAY, ON

En route to Thunder Bay we travel through the popular sportsman resort of [Kenora](#) passing by Husky the Musky, with a stop at [Kakabeka Falls](#).

SEPTEMBER 14 | SAULT STE. MARIE, ON

Our scenic drive to our next stop: The Canadian Shield. Ruggedly beautiful upland that comprises nearly half of Canada. Rivers meander through a maze of lakes, dense forests and ancient rock on their way to the largest fresh water lake in the world, Lake Superior.

SEPTEMBER 15-16 | OTTAWA, ON

Travelling along the Mattawa and Ottawa rivers passing Chalk River, we arrive in our nation's capital. We [tour the City](#), view the [Parliament Buildings](#), [24 Sussex Drive](#) and enjoy a [free afternoon](#) to explore the many historical sites and museums.

SEPTEMBER 17-18 | QUEBEC CITY, QC

Bienvenue to Quebec! Steeped in old world charm, it is also vibrantly modern. Our day 1 tour of [Montreal](#) features [Notre Dame Cathedral and Mt. Royal](#). In Quebec City a local tour guide will showcase Canada's oldest and most European city. See how bread is made in the outdoor stone ovens and enjoy a typical [Quebec style lunch](#). Following a visit to The Shrine of [Ste. Anne de Beaupre](#) we return to the city to the old walled city to shop and explore.

SEPTEMBER 19 | FREDERICKTON, NB

Stops today include [St. Jean Port Jolie](#), home to North America's largest concentration of wood carvers, and the world's longest covered bridge in [Hartland](#) before arriving at our destination.

SEPTEMBER 20-21 | CHARLOTTETOWN, PEI

En route to our destination we stop in Moncton at [Magnetic Hill](#), where vehicles mysteriously coast uphill. We then take the 8 mile [Confederation Bridge](#) to Canada's smallest province for two nights. On day two enjoy a relaxing morning visiting the waterfront shops. That afternoon we visit [Anne of Green Gables](#) and [PEI National Park](#), later enjoying dinner at [New Glasgow Lobster Suppers](#).

SEPTEMBER 22-23 | BADDECK, NS

A ferry crossing of the Northumberland Strait takes us to mainland Nova Scotia. On arrival in Baddeck we visit the [Alexander Graham Bell Museum](#). On day 2, windswept hills and magnificent scenery combine for an unforgettable trip around the [Cabot Trail](#), with a stop to [picnic](#) under a canopy of trees and autumn leaves.

SEPTEMBER 24-25 | HALIFAX, NS

A local [tour guide](#) takes us on an afternoon tour of the Maritimes' oldest and 2nd largest city. On day 2 we visit [Peggy's Cove](#), Canada's most photographed spot, where we will enjoy [lunch](#) - and you will be able to explore the area.

SEPTEMBER 26 | SAINT JOHN, NS

Travelling around the head of the Bay of Fundy we stop at [Cape Hopewell](#) to learn about this spot with the highest tides in the world and to see the [Flower Pot Rocks](#). Saint John is a

splendid example of historical buildings and a modern waterfront. No visit would be complete without taking in the [Reversing Falls](#) of the Saint John River.

SEPTEMBER 27 | EDMUNDSTON, NB

En route to Edmunston, fall colours explode as we make our way along the "Rhine of Canada". We stop at St. Andrews, a treasure trove of beautiful architecture, unparalleled scenery and rich marine life.

SEPTEMBER 28 | VAUDREUIL DORION, QC

A return to Quebec takes us along the St. Lawrence River dotted with picturesque farms and villages. This evening we partake in a Sugaring Off Feast at [Sucrierie de la Montagne](#).

SEPTEMBER 29 | GANONOQUE, QC

Our destination is Ganonoque, the [Gateway to the 1000 Islands](#). A 2.5 hour cruise will highlight spectacular scenery, lavish homes and the shipping activity along the seaway.

SEPTEMBER 30-OCTOBER 1 | NIAGRA FALLS, ON

In [Niagra Falls](#) we sail to the base of the Falls. On day 2 we take a leisurely drive on the [Niagra Parkway](#) making scenic stops along the way. We visit the [Welland Canal](#) in hopes that we will see a ship pass through the historic waterway, and spend the afternoon exploring the shops and Falls.

OCTOBER 2 | MIDDLEBURY, IN

Arriving in [Amish Country](#), this evening we partake in a traditional [family style meal](#).

OCTOBER 3 | ROCKFORD, IL

This morning we spend more time exploring Northern Indiana's [Amish Country](#). A [local guide](#) will provide insight into the simple ways of this unique culture where people farm and travel without automation. Horse and buggies are a common sight on the roadways. We travel past Chicago and arrive in Rockford for the night.

OCTOBER 4 | ST. CLOUD, WI

Winding our way through the rolling hills of Wisconsin's dairyland, and the Twin Cities we arrive in St. Cloud where we have a [Getaway Vacations Appreciation Dinner](#).

OCTOBER 5 | MINOT, ND

We stop for the night in Minot for some rest and relaxation.

OCTOBER 6 | MOOSE JAW, SK

We celebrate the last day of our trip in Moose Jaw where we can take in the mineral pools or maybe have some fun at the casino.
