Have breaks allowed 2 hours and 3.5 hours in SectionsSafe and Effective Care EnvironmentThis section includes 2 subcategories: Safety and Infection Control - accounts for 13% of all exam questions. Care management - accounts for about 20% of all exam questions. Topics include ethical practice, informed consent, continuity of care, error prevention, hazardous materials, standard precautions, etc. Health Promotion and Maintenance This category includes 10% of all exam questions. Topics include things like baby care, health promotion programs, self-care, lifestyle choices, and health screening.Psychosocial Integrity This category includes 10% of all exam questions. Topics include things like chemical addiction, End of Life Care, Support Systems, and Stress Management.Physiological Integrity This section includes 4 subcategories: Basic Care and Comfort - is about 10% of all exam questions. Although there is no numerical score provided if you fail, a full breakdown report where you need to concentrate your training is provided. Many students fail the exam on the first attempt, so definitely don't despair if it happens to you. By registering for the exam To register for the exam, students must apply to the National Board of State Board of Care. The application can be made by phone or in writing, and must be accompanied by a \$200 exam fee. Once your application is approved, you will be allowed to register for the exam.
