4. Put God first in all that you do, and lean on Him to help you carry the cross daily.
5. The Christian walk is a daily, living relationship with God. Keep up with your quiet time each day, be at worship each Sunday.

Introduction

We go through life distracted

Luke 10:40-42 *But Martha was distracted with much serving, and she came up to him, and said, "Lord, don't you care that my sister left me to serve alone? Ask her therefore to help me." Jesus answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are **anxious and troubled about many things**, but one thing is needed. Mary has chosen the good part, which will not be taken away from her."*



Introduction

1 Kings 20:39-40 Your servant went out into the midst of the battle; and, behold, a man turned aside, and brought a man to me, and said, Keep this man: if by any means he be missing, then shall your life be for his life, or else you shall pay a talent of silver.

*As your servant was **busy here and there**, he was gone. The king of Israel said to him, So shall your judgment be; yourself have decided it.*



Introduction

Hebrews 12:1-2 *Therefore let us also, seeing we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, **lay aside every weight and the sin which so easily entangles us,** and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, **looking to Jesus,** the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.*

1. Looking at Christ

- Jesus Christ must be key in our lives
- Colossians 1:18 *He is the head of the body, the assembly, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the pre-eminence.*
- In everything – what would Jesus do?
- What would He have us do?
- Let Him be the deciding factor

2. Prioritize People

- People matter more than things
- *“As I have loved you, so you must love one another”* – John 13:34
- We are called to value people, not count numbers and measure success
- Treat one another with respect, as friends – as we want to be treated
- *“So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them”* Matthew 7:12
- People are not a bother, but priority
