BIO

Asa Leveaux, four-time author, two-time best-selling author and Chief Strategy and Revenue Officer of Leveaux Group, Inc, identifies his life's mission to possess a joyous existence conceived by enlightened thought and achieved through love, passion and wealth!

Asa Leveaux was born in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma and grew up in the suburbs. Though picket fences were present there were also neighborhoods bearing nicknames such as "Murder One" and "Panic Zone" that had a significant effect on how he saw the world. Luckily he was able to slide underneath the radar of what was happening around him due to the sometimes overwhelming responsibilities of being the eldest of five and getting a taste of what entrepreneurship had to offer. By the time Asa had reached the age of thirteen he had already done his best as a "candy dealer" in the Church of God in Christ congregation that he was raised as well as investing long hours each day cutting lawns from blocks away.

Asa Leveaux began to become recognized for his leadership abilities while in high school by being accepted into the Youth Leadership Exchange program in Oklahoma City. Though he was made aware of life changing possibilities he was also doing his best managing taking his now Alzheimer stricken great-grandmother to a care facility across town each morning before school, working a job at McDonalds as well as being groomed as the next preacher in his family just like his parents.

Once graduating high school Asa immediately took action and was accepted to Oklahoma State University. Being away from everything he had ever known also gave him an introduction to the epicurean side of himself that he had never been aware. This new awareness resulted in him eventually having a 1.9 gpa. Not knowing what to do to pay for school so that he could bounce back from the level he had placed himself he entered the Oklahoma Army National Guard two months after the attack on 9/11.

Asa has had a significant career in the armed forces that includes multiple deployments, various leadership opportunities, receiving the Bronze Star as well as reaching the desired rank of Captain. For nearly seventeen years he dedicated himself to understanding military logistics on a wholesale and retail level.

During this time of serving in the armed forces Asa began to educate and implement all things entrepreneurial. His endeavors included a daycare center that served over one-hundred children, a profitable commercial janitorial company, a retail store that offered multi-cultural regalia as well as a windshield repair company that was proud to serve the federal government.

Currently Asa Leveaux is entrusting his time to ensuring that entrepreneurs and those within the LGBTQ+ community are served as the founder of Genius Academy and Queer School which is a non profit initiative through the Leveaux Foundation. He has also found success as the creator of the Oklahoma Black Business Expo with his strategic alliance with the Shark Tank television show.
