About the author: Robert H. Frank received his Ph.D. in Statistics from the University of California, Berkeley in 1971 and his doctorate in economics in 1972, also from the University of California, Berkeley. He is Professor of Economics at Goldwyn Smith University, where he has taught since 1972 and where he currently has a joint appointment at the Department of Economics and Johnson High School of Management. It published a publication on a range of issues, including price and wage discrimination, utility pricing, the measurement of periods of unemployment and the impact of foreign direct investment. Over the past few years, his research has focused on competition and cooperation in economic and social behaviour. Professor Antonovich received her bachelor's degree from Brown University in 1993 and her doctorate in economics from the University of Wisconsin in 2000. Soon after, she enrolled in the Faculty of Economics at the University of California, San Diego, where she still works. Professor Antonovich is known for her excellent teaching and innovative use of technology in the classroom. Its very popular introductory level of microeconomics course regularly enrolls more than 450 students each fall. She also teaches the economics of work at both the undergraduate and master's levels. In 2012, she received the UCSD Economics Department Award for Best Master's Degree. Professor Antonovik's research focused on racial discrimination, gender discrimination, affirmative action, intergenerational income mobility, education and wage dynamics. Her articles appeared in the American Economic Review, The Economics and Statistics Survey, the Journal of Labor Economics, and the Journal of Human Resources. She is a member of the American Economic Association and the Society of Labor Economists. Professor Geffetz received a bachelor's degree in physics and philosophy from Tel Aviv University in 1999 and a doctorate in economics from Princeton University in 2005. He is an associate professor of economics at the Samuel Curtis Johnson Graduate School of Management at Cornell University, where he has been teaching since 2005. Bringing the real world into the classroom, Professor Geffetz has created a unique macroeconomics course that introduces basic concepts and tools from economic theory and applies them to current news and global events. Its popular classes are accepted by hundreds of students each year, on the Cornell Ithaca campus and, through live video conferencing, in dozens of cities across the U.S., Canada and beyond. Professor Geffetz's research has outdior the social and cultural aspects of economic behaviour by focusing on the mechanisms that govern consumer choice and on the links between individual well-being and policy-making. He published scientific work on household consumption patterns, individual economic and survey methodology, and measurements. He was a visiting researcher at the Bank of Israel during 2011, is currently a researcher at the Faculty of the National Bureau of Economic Research (NBER), and is a member of the editorial board of Social Choice and Social Security.
