Peterborough Energy Action has asked the members of the Peterborough Unitarian Universalist Church to endorse their "Ready for 100" goals. This is our response.


In 2006, our Unitarian Universalist Association adopted a Statement of Conscience that included this statement:

We as Unitarian Universalists are called to join with others to halt practices that fuel global warming/climate change, to instigate sustainable alternatives, and to mitigate the impending effects of global warming/climate change with just and ethical responses.

Locally, the members of our Peterborough Unitarian Universalist Church congregation endorse and support Peterborough Energy Action's goals: (1) By 2030, the Town of Peterborough will rely entirely on renewable sources of electricity. (2) By 2050, the Town of Peterborough will rely on renewable sources for all other energy needs, including heating and transportation.

We understand that Peterborough Energy Action is committed to promoting a just and equitable transition to renewable energy for all. Our Unitarian Universalist principles support this action as one step in the process of halting practices that fuel climate change.
