RUN AID STATION VOLUNTEERS – BUSSELTON 100

Location: Run Course, Busselton Foreshore at designated aid stations (2)

Times: SATURDAY 29th April 1-5pm

Equipment Supplied: T-shirt, hat, lunch

Roles:

- Ensure there are adequate drinks allocated to drink stations and continually refill drinks when necessary. This includes sports drink and cola drink as required.
- Hand out drinks to participants in a safe and professional manner to minimize disruption to their race – this includes use of hygienic gloves.
- Ensure area around drink station is free of used cups and bottles.
- Collect up all used cups and bottles in bags provided for disposal.
- Pack unused drinks back into cartons and pack up the drink station at the end of the event.

COACH'S CORNER

Trish has a been an active member of AUSSI and Masters Swimming for over 25 years, swimming at Somerset before helping to establish the new Busselton Masters Swimming Club in February 2015, with 20 inaugural members.

Trish is a formidable swimmer, maintaining about 5 swims per weak and up to 500km per season. Trish is known for her persistence in cold water and swimming without a wetsuit – preferring the Budgie Smugglers in several exotic patterns. She leads by example.

Trish has had and maintains several roles in the Club. As Secretary from Feb 2015 until October 2021, Trish managed the Clubs Day to day activities, business and engagement with members and community. Trish engages with all the members and provides mentoring as well as regular communication to ensure all existing and new members were supported and kept informed of Club activities. As secretary, Trish had the central role of managing the

membership database, emails and related communi-

cation.

Trish now volunteers as Coach and was previously the Coach coordinator for the Club. She provides pool deck support for Masters Swimmers and also coaches for the Geographe Leisure Centre. Trish has built and maintains support of the Masters WA swimming coach, Kareena Preston, and created several opportunities for her to come to Busselton in the last 18 months. Trish continues to support the clubs existing coaches and provides a mentorship program for new coaches.

However, at Busselton Trish is most respected and awarded by her interest and actions in seeking opportunity to encourage new members to join the Club, in particular in starting what Busselton now runs as its signature welcome event, the Re-Start program.

Re-Start is an initiative to encourage locals to come and try swimming, either as an exswimmer, or just a causal swimmer who want to improve their skills or achieve new personal goals. With the help of the Club and the coaching team, Trish has now run several Re-start programs and attracted many of our current members to Busselton and Masters WA.

Over recent years and particularly the past 24 months, Trish has made several voluntary trips to Perth to represent Busselton Masters Swimming Club related to Coaching clinics and education sessions provided by Masters Swimming WA. As a country member, this involves a large time cost.
