

Ramsey Foundation Scholarship Program

The Ramsey Foundation Scholarship Program is rooted in the philosophy of empowerment through education. We aim to inspire and assist dedicated students in their pursuit of higher learning, in recognition that their newly developed skills and knowledge can be used to make a significant positive impact in society. The scholarship amount varies based on individual needs and circumstances, with the potential for renewal subject to the board's discretion.

Objective

Our goal is to relieve students from the stress that often accompanies self-financed education so they can concentrate on their academic pursuits, free from the worry of extensive student loans or the need to maintain full-time employment while studying. This scholarship is designed to benefit committed students who have completed the FAFSA and are seeking additional support to supplement a previously awarded PELL grant, other grants or scholarships, or those who have been unable to secure financial aid due to extenuating circumstances. Preference is given to:

- Established students studying Education, Physical Therapy, Nursing, Social Work, Computer Science, Math, Business, Aviation, Aeronautical or other Engineering or technical fields
- First generation students, those previously in foster care, displaced homemakers, or students with challenging personal circumstances

Eligibility Criteria

- ❖ Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 (or 2.7 if working while studying)
- Demonstration of financial need
- Full-time or part-time work history and/or community service
- Intention of completing a bachelor's degree or higher
- Enrolled as a full-time student at a fully accredited college or university

Application Requirements

- ❖ Transcripts & proof of current, full-time enrollment at a fully accredited college or university
- Resume detailing education, school activities, work history and/or community service
- Demonstration of financial need (FAFSA and completed MTRF-provided spreadsheet)
- Written essay sharing your story, including how you've overcome adversity, an explanation of why you are driven to achieve a 4-year college degree, and your goals for creatively inspiring future generations
