OVERVIEW

Climate Reality Leaders advance climate solutions in the communities by raising awareness and performing various Acts of Leadership (AOLs) that inspire action at all levels of society. Though the branch office, located in Montreal, remains present at all times to offer Climate Reality Leaders support, it is beneficial for these volunteer speakers to have a mentor in their area who is well engrained in the local network of activists, who is familiar with the regional context in terms of issues and culture, and who can provide an on-the-ground friendly face to turn to.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Playing an active role in mobilizing, inspiring and supporting Climate Reality Leaders;
- Introducing new Climate Reality Leaders to the regional members of the Leadership Corps;
- Passing on the information disseminated by the Branch office;
- Organizing events at least once a year
 - To build a sense of fellowship and team-building
 - To create opportunities for networking
 - To keep Climate Reality Leaders engaged, motivated and feeling appreciated.
- Relaying the needs of Climate Reality Leaders to the branch office;
- Identifying success stories to be shared across the Climate Reality Leader network;
- Recruiting high-potential leaders to apply for Leadership Corps trainings;
- Participating in regular Lead Mentor calls and individual calls with the branch office;
- Building bridges between people and between organizations, and looping Climate Reality Leaders into a network of local actors in climate change;
- Encouraging mentees to perform Acts of Leadership and to log them in the Reality Hub;
- Being the support system for Climate Reality Leaders; the person they turn to when they have questions, or when they seek guidance, advice, encouragement or support;
- Motivating Climate Reality Leaders to remain active for the climate and involved with The Climate Reality Project Canada (CRPC);



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- Remaining informed of climate-related news, events and opportunities, and bringing salient information to mentees' attention;
- Being the main point of contact for Climate Reality Leaders, and the bridge between CRPC and Climate Reality Leaders. As much as possible, we want Climate Reality Leaders to receive information via their Lead Mentor; it is therefore important that information be relayed when it is requested, in order to ensure that no CRL is left out of the loop;
- Inversely, we ask that Lead Mentors inform CRPC of any useful information that may come from mentees;
- Joining and keeping an eye on the Lead Mentors' Facebook / Slack group.
