NOAW will be the FediVariety's launch of the upcoming report on the now-closed European Data Protection Supervisor (EDPS) pilot project, 'EU Voice/Video'. The EDPS pilot was one of the first to integrate self-hosted Fediverse instances into cross-institutional (EU) public administration. Insights and recommendations derived from our analysis will be a start for a discussion.
