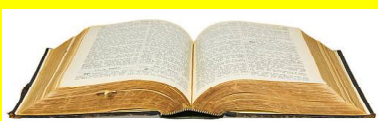

The Ladies' Care team is led by June Dhanabalan and Annie Koh. June is the church's secretary and prepares the worship projections.



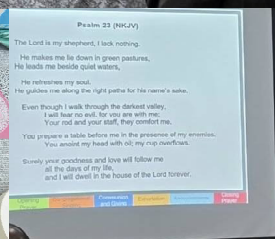
Elaine hosts the Thursday gatherings in her home. Kang Hwei helps out in counting the Sunday contributions with Annie keeping record of our accounts.



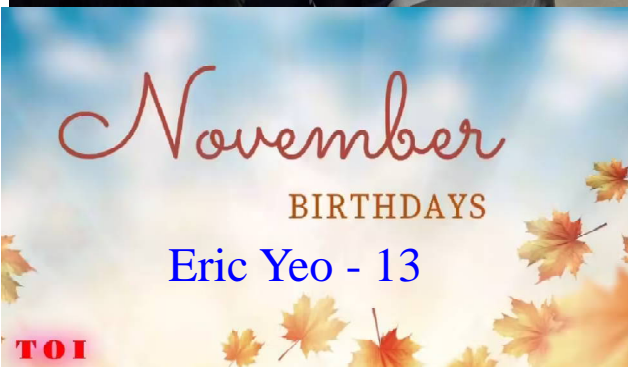

# Open Your Eyes

- Sense the presence of God

2 Kings 6:17 *Elisha prayed, and said, Yahweh, Please open his eyes, that he may see. Yahweh opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.*

Hebrews 11:24-27 *By faith, Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to share ill treatment with God's people, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a time; accounting the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he looked to the reward. By faith, he left Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.*

*2 Kings 7:9 Then they said one to another, We aren't doing right. This day is a day of good news, and we hold our peace: if we wait until the morning light, punishment will overtake us; now therefore come, let us go and tell the king's household.*

*Example of Andrew - John 1:40-41 One of the two who heard John, and followed him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his own brother, Simon, and said to him, "We have found the Messiah!" (which is, being interpreted, Christ) .*
