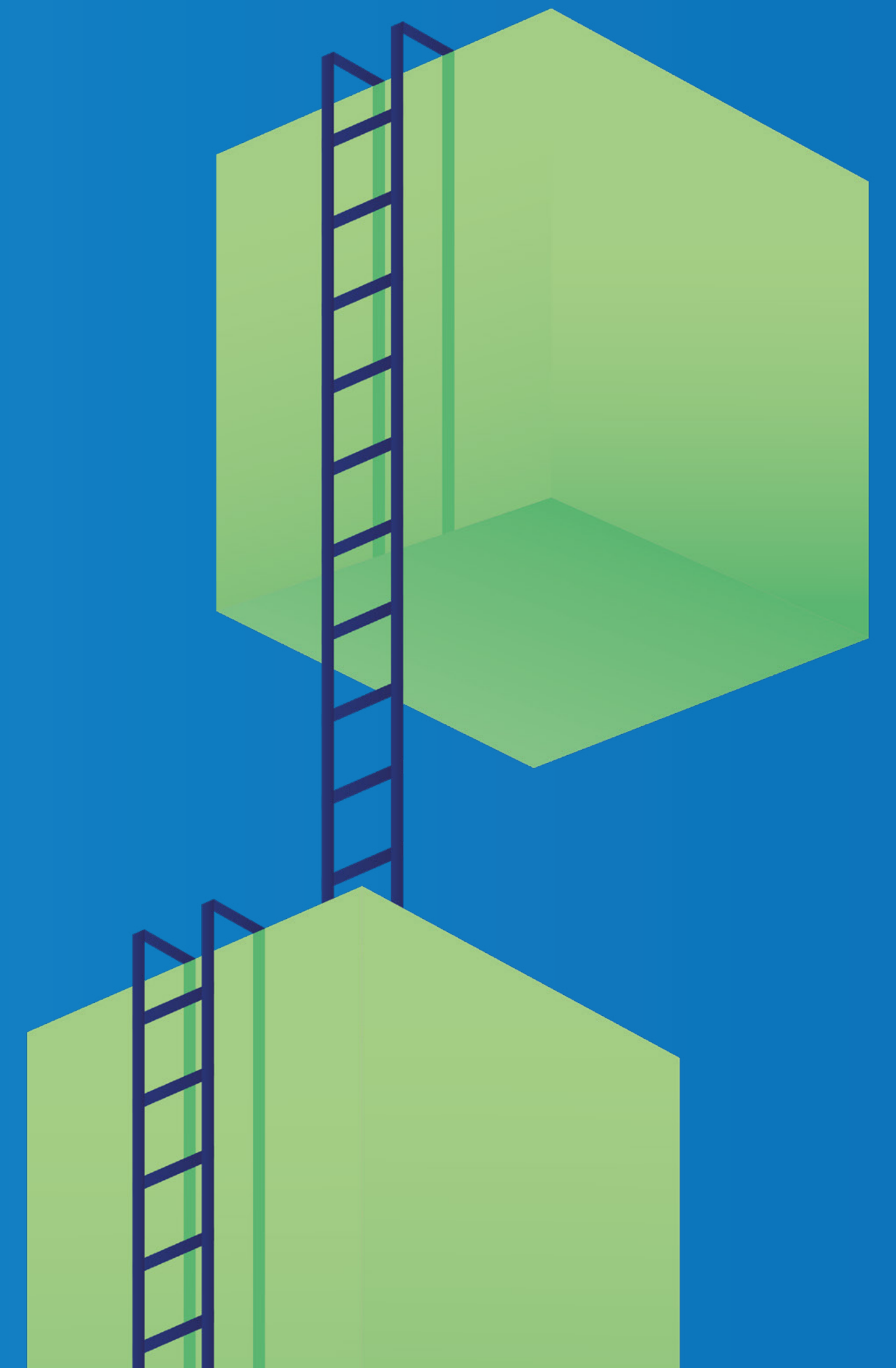
Excellerators Work Insight Scheme
