Save the date for our End of Year Graduation in the Church Sanctuary. More information to come as we get closer to the day. Family and friends are welcome to attend the celebration of our graduates.

Important Reminders:

- *Please drop off and pick up your child on time. Teachers have a scheduled time to be at the door, as other times they are needed in the classroom with the students to continue their daily routine. This has become increasingly important as we added transition times to accommodate the extra aftercare hour. Please make sure to pick up your child no later than 5:00 pm.
- *We are seeing a lot of rain boots at school, but children struggle to walk, run, and they can pose a hazard at school in the playground structure. Please bring a pair of Velcro shoes to school with your child when they insist on bringing boots. We will change their shoes at school. It is especially important on Wednesdays when coach Allek is at school helping with playground activities and assessing children's large motor growth.
- *We ask that you keep your child home if he or she is not feeling well or you suspect COVID-19 exposure. If your child looks to be under the weather when he or she wakes up, please give your child a day at home to rest and make sure he/she is well, as symptoms can worsen as the day goes on. If children come to school sick, not only will they spread germs, but your child will not enjoy their day at school feeling sick, and recover may take longer without proper rest. There are cases of flu, a stomach bug, and we are seeing lots of allergies at school. Please check with your doctor if your child shows symptoms.
- *We follow a 24-hour health policy. If your child is home sick, or was sent home due to illness, your child needs to be <u>symptom-free and/or on antibiotics for at least 24 hours</u> before he or she is able to return to school. This guideline helps ensure everyone is healthy at school and exposure is kept at a minimum. Thank you for helping to keep our school community healthy and helping us remain open.
- *We have a lice and nit free policy. Children have to be lice and nit free to attend school. A child with a positive case will be sent home and needs to be rechecked upon returning. Our preschool children work and play in very close contact and limits the spread.
