Dr. Hans plans to experiment on Fanga with his genetic drug accelerator and introduces a canine with him. However, the drug eventually leads to his death. Angel says (through her mind) Max will come to save him, but when Flock arrives, they are too late. Max desperately tries to bring fangs around, but to no avail. She finally punches the needle adrenaline into her chest and after a few moments, Fang returns to life. Dylan then tries to kill Dr. Hans with the needle he finds, but when he realizes that it is against Flock killing him in cold blood, he stabs himself in a suicide attempt, but lives. In the epilogue, Total marries Akila. Fang leaves the reception early, and when Flock returns home after the reception, Max goes looking for Fang, but instead finds a letter addressed to her.
