There are lights that can warn you that your car is low in oil, remind you to wear your seat belt and indicate a possible problem with your ABS system. ABS means Antilock braking system. When activated, it pumps the brakes very quickly to allow the car to stop more efficiently on slippery or dangerous roads. The ABS light comes on when there is a problem with the car's braking system. This may mean that ABS brakes need fluid or malfunction. If the ABS fire stays on, it indicates a major problem that has disabled the ABS brakes. A major problem could be a faulty wiring harness or wheel speed sensor. If the light comes on, it indicates a minor problem and the ABS brakes can still work. This is more likely a problem with low brake fluid or a wet or worn brake pad. Diagnosing a problem with the ABS braking system can be complicated. In general, it is best to take the car to a certified mechanic. The ABS system is essential for safe driving and must be in good working order at all times. Time.
